For example, if a team had their 3 pickups to make 10 & 2 players didn't show up, or whatever the case to only give them 8 players with their 3 pickups, if there is an eligible player of the same level or lower available to give them the minimum 9 players with 3 females, they should be allowed an "Emergency 4<sup>th</sup> Pickup" to be eligible for play so they don't have to forfeit the entire tournament. But this would not be needed if the no deadline on hardship motion gets passed.
