3. State of the WWCA Address (Moe)

Pete Moe discussed the things that have happened within the past year for the WWCA.

- a. Overview of Work
 - i. Passage of girls state wrestling by the Board of Control in the spring
 - ii. Funding and completion for the George Martin display at the Chula Vista Dome (WI Dells)
 - iii. Cancellation of Annual Clinic and GMHF Banquet
 - iv. WWCA met numerous times since the spring
 - v. Organized 1st virtual clinic
 - vi. Made recommendations to the WIAA about COVID-19 guidelines
 - vii. Continue to work with the WIAA
- b. Membership Fee
 - i. WWCA Executive Committee voted to raise membership fees from \$25.00 to \$35.00
 - ii. There will be minimal impact on overall cost of the clinic
 - iii. Help supply funds for the Nicholas Suite
- c. Nicholas Suite
 - i. Cost is getting excessive
 - ii. Need to find alternative ways to fund
 - iii. Need to be fiscally responsible
- d. Future Work
 - i. Seeding the individual state tournament

- ii. 7 and 7 rule for competitions to match count/event count
- iii. Working with the WIAA on girls wrestling

4. COVID Guidelines (Moe)

- a. 6-7 days in between competitions
 - i. 1 competition per week
 - ii. Same days of competitions each week (Fri-Fri, Sat-Sat)
- b. Masks
 - i. Masks need to follow the statewide order (11/21 expiration)
 - ii. Compete with masks on under the statewide order
 - iii. No neck gaiters
- c. Non-School Competitions
 - i. Kids can compete in up to 2 non WIAA events
 - ii. Paperwork approval - talk with your AD
 - iii. This competition does fall within the 6-7 day window for WIAA rule
 - iv. Cannot use any school resources
 - v. School coaches cannot coach at those events
- d. WWCA Continued work with the WIAA

5. NFHS Rules Changes/Season Reminders (Moe)

- a. NFHS weigh-in procedure change
 - i. Will need to weigh-in shoulder to shoulder in singlets
 - ii. Allows for females to weigh in with male athletes
 - iii. Probably helps out during a pandemic
