



In Accordance with USA Hockey and Minnesota Hockey, Roseau Youth Hockey Players, Coaches and Spectators will do the following:

1. Practice Physical Distancing
2. Wash hands often and practicing safe hygiene habits
3. Clean surfaces and equipment between uses
4. Stay home when sick or experiencing any covid-19 symptoms

Player/Coach/Spectator Guidelines

- Players should arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to practice times and should exit within 15 minutes. Goalies are allowed an additional 10 minutes.
- Locker room may be used for practice times. Social distancing/masking rules must be followed. District 16 rules require locker room use to be monitored by an adult. (SQ/10U+)
- No spectators/parents/visitors allowed in arena to watch practice (PW/12U+)
- Teams that have practice before school (early morning) may leave their bags at the arena after practice, but they are NOT to hang equipment up to dry in the locker room. Equipment MUST be put away in hockey bag. Hockey equipment should be dried and sanitized at home. (PW/12U+)
- Coach or Team Manager must provide a list of players and their contact information to Public Health upon request in the event of a positive covid test within the team.
- District 16 rules will be followed for games (home and away district games):
 - Games should follow the USAH & MH Return-to-Play Guidelines
 - Two coaches on the bench and must remain masked at all times
 - If at all possible come to games dressed (minus skates and helmet) as locker rooms may not be available
 - Arrive 20-30 minutes prior to game time and leave the building within 15 minutes after the game
 - No congregating in arenas before or after games
 - Between periods DO NOT go to a locker room – stay on the bench (except for personal reasons and limit the number of players.)
 - Only two adults (16 & older) per player per team in attendance and they must be masked at all times.
 - If a sibling is playing in an out of town game, as a sibling then they may attend another sibling's game. BUT they must remain near (very near) parents and follow the social distance rule and be masked.
 - Fans allowed in facilities 10 minutes prior to games and must exit immediately following the game.
 - Face coverings will be mandatory for all (players, coaches, referees and fans) upon entering or leaving the buildings. Once the players and referees go to the playing surface they will be allowed to remove their face coverings.
 - Referees should remain six feet from all when possible (especially after a whistle).
 - Scheduling of games must allow time for disinfecting.

Roseau Youth Hockey COVID Rink Policy

- Concessions can be open if (ONLY IF) they meet guidelines established by the governor and MN Dept of Health.
- Per our District 16 Director: Failure to follow these instructions will result in cancellation of travel at all levels for the association.

Squirt/10U Policy - all of the above rules, with the exception of the following items:

- Practices: One adult per player is allowed to assist with skate tightening, but must leave the arena when player is fully dressed. (no staying to watch practice).

Tiny Mite/Mite/6U/8U Policy - all of the above, with the exception of the following items:

- No locker room use for practices -
- Players should arrive to the rink already dressed - tie skates and put on helmets in the lobby
- One adult spectator is allowed at practices to help get dressed and may stay to watch practice
- Adult must stay social distanced from others and use a face covering while in the arena
