Scholarships: One (given annually)

Amount: \$1000.00

Prerequisites: To qualify, each applicant must have played at least one full season in Bow Youth Football and a high school football program.

Qualifying applicants must submit, with their “**The Dalton J. Fenn Memorial Scholarship Fund**” application, an essay describing what Bow Youth Football has meant to them and what role the P.R.I.D.E. philosophy has played in their lives during their years of schooling..
