



CEVA POWER LEAGUE – 2021 SEASON

Spectator Policy

SPECTATORS

Spectator policies will be determined by the host of each tournament, in conjunction with CEVA and/or local health departments. **Until further notice (as of 3/31), spectators will not be permitted at CEVA-owned tournaments.**

ENTRY LIMITS

Specific limitations will be announced the week of 4/5. Only rostered individuals may enter a facility.

CONTACT TRACING

Contact information for club players and staff is collected through SportsEngine and AES, and will be provided to the appropriate organizations should it become necessary.

SANITIZERS & DISINFECTANTS

CEVA will have hand sanitizer, disinfecting wipes, and other cleaning agents available at both facilities. Teams and spectators are encouraged to also bring their own sanitizers as they see fit.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

All participants should take care to exercise social distancing whenever possible.

ENTRY PROCEDURES

Upon entry at either facility, each participant will have their temperature checked by a staff member with a digital thermometer, or will be subjected to a health screening. A participant that registers a temperature above 100.4 will not be permitted to enter the facility.

FACE MASK REQUIREMENTS

Participants are required to wear a face covering at all times in the facility. No exceptions. Prohibited face coverings include plastic face shields by themselves, a covering incorporating a valve that's designed to facilitate exhalation, mesh masks, lace masks, or other coverings with openings, holes, visible gaps, or vents.

CEVA will not simply "waive" this requirement, as it is well established that communicable diseases can spread through droplets exhaled from the mouth and nose. There are no exceptions to this policy.

CAMPING & TAILGATING

Do not anticipate "camp areas" being available within the facility. Teams should enter a facility prepared to play and should leave the facility if they are not playing or working. CEVA discourages social activities, such as tailgating, at these events – and any activities that lead to congregating among members of different households.
