Saint of the Week Saint Cecilia was a beautiful, young woman, born to a wealthy family in Rome. At a young age, she took a vow of chastity and abstinence, dedicating herself entirely to God. Although she was promised in marriage to a young man, Valerian, Cecilia was determined to keep her vow. On the day of her wedding, she sang to God in her heart and was sent an angel to guard and protect her. When it came time to consummate the marriage, Cecilia told her new husband about her vow and the angel protecting her. Valerian asked to see the angel as proof. Cecilia told him, if he were to be baptized, he would be able to see the angel. Valerian was baptized, and upon return to his wife, he found her in the company of an angel. Cecilia led not only her husband to be baptized, but over 400 people were baptized due to her faith and courage. These baptisms upset the Roman emperor, who ordered the execution of Cecilia. Many attempts were made, but Cecilia remained faithful and protected. Ultimately, she was put to death, and it is said that she heard the music of the angels as she died. Cecilia is the patroness of musicians and reminds us to be steadfast and strong in our faith.

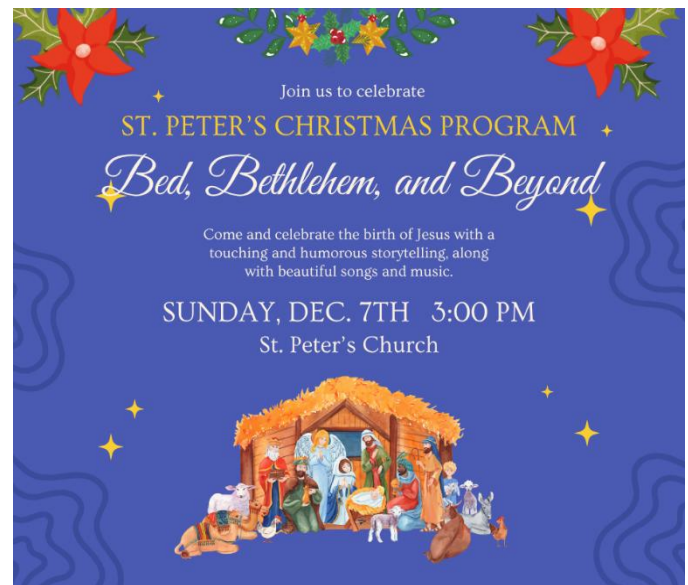
