2020 Ion Adult Hockey Tournament Rules and Structure

USA Hockey Adult Classic Rules Tournament Structure

PERIODS: (3) - 12 MINUTE PERIODS - STOPPED TIME

NOTE: If the score difference is (6) goals or more at any time during the third period, the clock goes to running time. If the score goes back to a difference of less than six goals, stopped time is reinstated.

WARM-UPS: Three (3) MINUTES (do not go on the ice before the Zamboni is off of the ice). The ice will be resurfaced before each game.

OVERTIME: TIED GAMES

- **PRELIMINARY ROUND GAMES: SHOOTOUT (No Overtime)**
 - If a game is tied at the end of regulation, a three man shoot-out will be held to determine a winner. Visitor team shoots first. If after the first three shooters, the score is still tied, a sudden death shoot-out (one skater each) shall continue until a winner is determined. All skaters on the players' bench are required to shoot before a player may shoot for a second time.
 - **NOTE:** Any player serving a penalty at the end of regulation play is NOT eligible to participate in the shootout.
- **SEMI-FINAL & CHAMPIONSHIP GAMES: OVERTIME, then a SHOOTOUT**

A five minute stopped time, 4 on 4, sudden death, overtime period will be played. If the score remains tied after the overtime, the above described shootout format will be used to determine a winner.

PENALTIES: 2 Minute MINOR, 5 Minute MAJOR, 10 Minute MISCONDUCT

Discipline For Excessive Penalties:

-(4) Penalties carry an automatic game ejection (remainder of game).

-Fighting WILL NOT be tolerated. Any players involved in a fight as deemed by the game officials will receive an automatic game misconduct (1 game suspension)

TIMEOUTS: Each team is allowed a One Minute Time Out per Game

EQUIPMENT: Players are required to follow USA Hockey equipment guidelines. Note: Hockey helmets must be worn.

GAME RESULTS: A maximum differential of six goals per game will be used for standings/tiebreaker purposes. ex. A score of 14-3 becomes 9-3; a score of 8-0 becomes 6-0. Clock will run when a 6 goal differential has been reached. If the losing team scores and the differential drops below 6, the clock will resume normal stoptime operations.

PLAYING RULES HIGHLIGHTS

Jersey colors: Home = Light; Visitor = Dark

No Checking is allowed.

Redline Icing

Slapshots are allowed.

Tag up offsides

STANDINGS & TIE BREAKERS

STANDINGS: STANDINGS WILL BE DETERMINED UTILIZING THE FOLLOWING POINT SYSTEM:

WIN IN REGULATION = 3 POINTS

SHOOT-OUT WIN = 2 POINTS

SHOOT-OUT LOSS = 1 POINT

LOSS IN REGULATION = 0 POINTS

TIE BREAKERS:

IF TEAMS ARE TIED IN THE STANDINGS, THE FOLLOWING TIE BREAKING RULES WILL APPLY (in order):

1. HEAD TO HEAD (results in the games played between the tied teams) Note: If a team defeated the other team(s) that they are tied with, they will be ranked ahead of those other teams.
2. GOAL DIFFERENTIAL – GOALS FOR MINUS GOALS AGAINST IN ALL GAMES PLAYED. Note: In a given game the goal differential will be a maximum of (6) regardless of a greater goal differential. Ex: 15-2 = 8-2
3. FEWEST GOALS ALLOWED FOR ALL GAMES PLAYED
4. PERIOD POINTS (won by each team).
 - 2 points for each period won
 - 1 point for each period tied
 - 1 point for a shutout in a period
5. FEWEST MINOR PENALTIES IN ALL GAMES PLAYED.
6. FEWEST TOTAL PENALTY MINUTES IN ALL GAMES PLAYED.
7. COIN TOSS

RULES: USA Hockey playing rules are in effect except for some modifications listed below.

- All players are required to follow USA Hockey equipment recommendations.
- This is a non-checking event. Body checking is not permitted at any level.
- Slap shots are allowed at all levels.
- The red line will be used for automatic icing.
- The tag-up rule will be used for off-sides.
- Any team who willingly forfeits a game will not be eligible for semi-final or final games in the event.

DIVISIONS:

- B- Co-Ed Advanced to Expert (Categories 1 and 2 below)
- C- Co-Ed Intermediate to Advanced (Categories 3 and 4 below)
- D- Co-Ed- Beginner to Intermediate (Categories 5 and 6 below)

All Players must be age 18 by June 1, 2020 to participate in this tournament
 Official USA Hockey T-1 Rosters must be submitted No Later than June 1, 2020
 All players will check in with photo ID at the front desk for their first game

Illegal players and teams:

- You will be required to rate each of your players on a 1-6 scale
 - 1- Professional (All levels and Europe)/NCAA/Major Junior/JuniorA
 - 2- Junior B/Non-Varsity College (ACHA)/Midget AAA/Prep School
 - 3- Junior C/High School/Competitive Midget
 - 4- Bantam/Pee Wee/Squirt/ Some competitive youth
 - 5- Very little youth hockey experience
 - 6- Didn't play as a youth

o Any player(s) that participated at any time during the current season (after September 1st) at any elite professional level (NHL, AHL, Europe) or on an NCAA Division I or III team are NOT eligible for this tournament.

o Any player(s) who participated in any other professional leagues (ECHL, CHL, IHL, UHL, SPHL, and AAHA) after December 31st of the current season are NOT eligible to for this tournament.

o If it is determined by the tournament director(s) at any point during the preliminary round games that a team (in the C division and below) as a whole are far above their competition that team will be permitted to play the three game guarantee, but will receive a 1-0 forfeit loss for those games and will not be permitted to advance to the championship round

- o All Players on the roster must play in at least one preliminary round game to be eligible for the playoff round.
- o Players may only play on one team in the tournament. Players cannot play for multiple teams in multiple divisions. Exceptions may be made for goaltenders in extenuating circumstances.
- o Game officials (referees) working games in the tournament are NOT PERMITTED to play for any team in the divisions that they officiate.
