- 7U - 9U boys and 8U girls tournament team tryouts (March 20)
 - Location: HYS Field House
 - Schedule:
 - 9 AM: 8U softball
 - 11 AM: 9U baseball
 - 2:00 PM: 8U baseball
- Baseball tournament team uniforms
 - Last year for the green button jerseys.
 - **Action item**: Nick Rentsch will reach out to various vendors to consider phasing in new uniforms this year and into the future. We will need a quick turnaround on uniforms, likely 4-5 weeks. Something for vendors to keep in mind when preparing options for consideration.

NEW BUSINESS/Discussion/Voting Items

- 2021 Registration/SportsEngine
 - Registration is all set to open on Friday, Jan. 8.
 - Coaches registration should be added
 - COVID waiver will be added to registration.
- Combining of softball league with HYS – Greg Reimann
 - Had a good meeting in December.
 - One item that still needs to be worked out is volunteer requirements for softball girls
 - Current volunteer hour requirements:
 - HYS: 4 hours per player max at 6 per family
 - GYS: 2 hours per player, no family max
- SCHEELS partnership update – Pat Wetzel

- o SCHEELS event date(s)
 - Historically the first Sat. in Apr. and the last Sat. in Apr. This year the first Sat. in April is Easter weekend so we may need to push that back to the second weekend in Apr. Pat is just starting to have this discussion with Julie. No dates set yet.
- o SCHEELS still has all of our league team shirts. We may need to add a sponsor or two and get more shirts printed.
- 2021 volunteer credits
 - o Discussed possibly changing the requirement. After further discussion decided to keep the requirement at 2 per player, no family max for Tee Ball and up players (no requirement for PeeWee Tee Ball).
- Sponsorship/Fundraising update – Pat Wetzel
 - o A lot of this work has been done since it will carry over from last year. Pat will reach out to sponsors soon.
- Opening Day – May 1 (for all leagues except Tee Ball and Pee Wee Tee Ball)
- Middle school fields
 - o Waiting to hear back from Jesse Mallmann to find out what the cost of
- Compliance Coordinator
 - o \$25 per person and includes background check and SafeSport certification.
 - o Dave can turn this on at anytime and it will track coaches that have completed. We may need to have a process for coaches that have SafeSport from another organization that is still valid to submit and track their certificates.

 - o Pat did reach out to Angie Gass to gather information on the calendars. Pat and Darin will work on getting the calendar raffle underway in the next few months.
- Register system for concession stand – Amanda DeHaai
 - o We have everything we need for the system. Amanda will be working on getting everything set up and running a test run.

- 7U Baseball Tournament Team head coach

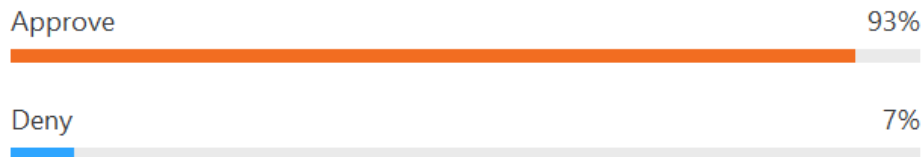
