



NOTEWORTHY

HOME COOKIN': The Vikings haven't had more than four home losses in a season since the 2003-04 season when they went 8-5 at home. That same season is the only losing season under head coach Dave Krauth in his 30 seasons at Augustana.

HI, MY NAME IS: Augustana only lost three seniors from last season, but welcome in seven new freshman/redshirt freshman to the mix this season.

NOW YOU SEES HER NOW YOU DONT: The Avon, South Dakota, standout has averaged 12.7 points a contest and has also pulled down 3.7 boards per game. Sees shoots at a team-high 57 percent clip from the field and 50 percent from deep.

SEEING DOUBLE: Augustana had five players record double figures in its season-opening win over Truman State. The last time the Vikings had that happen was against SMSU on Feb. 23, 2019.

BLOCK PARTY: Augustana ranks fifth with 3.4 blocks per contest and has recorded 31 total on the season. As a team, the Vikings rank 82nd in the nation in blocks per contest.

GRAND THEFT BASKETBALL: Augie ranks second in steals per game with 10.56 and 95 total. Abby Hora and Lauren Sees rank third and 10th in the NSIC with 2.0 and 1.7 steals respectively.

A DECADE TO REMEMBER: Augie has recorded a 235-86 record in the last 10 years that also included four trips to the NCAA Tournament and the program's first appearance in the NCAA Division II Final Four in 2013 as well as the NSIC Conference Tournament Championship. The Vikings also returned to the tournament in 2018 after an NSIC regular season and conference tournament title with their season ending in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16.

CYA 2019, HELLO 2020: The Vikings earned a 28-14 record in 2019. Vishe' Rabb earned NSIC Freshman of the Year while Hana Metoxen, Lynsey Prosser and Shelby Selland all earned spots on All-NSIC teams.

STORYLINES

- Coming off splitting the weekend against the Golden Eagles and the Beavers the Vikings are looking to enter the holiday break on a win.
- The Vikings rank third in the NSIC in rebounding offense with 41.1 rebounds per game and rank 72nd in the nation.
- Augustana ranks second in the NSIC with a 8.22 turnover margin and ranks third in field goal percentage defense holding opponents to 37 percent shooting from the field.
- Abby Hora ranks third in the NSIC with 2.0 steals per contest while as a team rank second with 10.56 steals per game.

SCOUTING THE OPPONENTS

Wayne State Wildcats (7-3, 3-2 NSIC)

Wayne State enters with a 7-3 record and 3-2 record in NSIC action. Recently, the Wildcats split a pair of games to Bemidji State and Minnesota Crookston. Wayne State opened conference play with a win over Augustana and Upper lowa before losing to Winona State.

The Wildcats are led by Erin Norling who averages 20.4 points per game while three others average double-figure scoring. Kylie Hammer recorded a career-high 21 points against the Vikings the last time the two-faced. The sophomore also finished with eight boards, five assists and three steals. As a team, they shoot 43 percent from the field and 34 percent from deep. The Wildcats average 77.9 points per game while allowing 68.7 points.

The Augustana women's basketball team was selected to finish fourth in the NSIC Preseason Coaches' Poll the league office announced. MSU Moorhead was picked to finish first after receiving nine first-place votes and 217 overall points. Augustana was picked to finish second in the South Division after amassing 39 points which is 10 points behind first-place Sioux Falls.

Rabb is the reigning NSIC Freshman of the Year and Augie's NSIC Player to Watch this season after averaging 10.7 points per game and 1.45 steals per game. The Springfield, Minnesota, native shot at a 46-percent clip and 33 percent from deep.

Metoxen also returns after being named to the NSIC All-Defensive team last season. The Apple Valley, Minnesota, native grabbed 39 steals to lead the Vikings defense. On the other side of the ball, the senior averaged 6 points and 4.2 boards a game.

The Vikings return four players that started at least 15 games or more last season in Vishe' Rabb, Abby Hora, Hana Metoxen and Janelle Shiffler.

David Krauth enters his 31st season at the helm of the Augustana women's basketball program in 2019-20.

During the 2018-19 season, Krauth led the Vikings to a 22-11 record. The Vikings 22 wins is the 14th time in the last 15 years that the Vikings have won at least 20 games in a single season. They have recorded 21, 20 win seasons since Krauth became head coach in 1989-90. He has had just one losing campaign.

The 2017-18 season marked another historic year for Augustana women's basketball.

The Vikings posted a 29-4 record, won a share of the NSIC regular season title for the first time in program history, won the NSIC South for the 2nd straight season, won the NSIC Tournament in dominating fashion, and advanced to the Sweet-16 in their 14th NCAA Tournament Appearance. The 29 wins are the most in program history, and the Vikings began the season 14-0, which is the best start to a season in program history.

Krauth made history in the regular season finale, when the Vikings defeated Upper Iowa 71-45 on Feb. 17, 2018, to give him his 600th career win. Krauth is the sixth active head coach with 600 or more wins and the 15th coach all-time to do so in Division II. He currently has a .70% winning percentage.

As has been a staple of his program, academics once again excelled with ten Vikings earning Academic All-NSIC honors. During Krauth's tenure, he has had 98 players named to Academic All-Conference teams. The team was also named to the WBCA Academic Top 25 Team Honor roll for the fifth straight season.

A highlight of his coaching career, the 2012-13 season was one for the ages, as Krauth's Vikings set a single-season school record for wins (28), which included being the NSIC Tournament and Central Region Tournament champions. The Vikings advanced to the national tournament semifinals by eliminating previously unbeaten and nationally top-ranked Clayton State in the opening round. Augustana's unprecedented run came to an end against Dowling College in the semifinals. The Vikings were ranked No. 4 in the final USA Today Sports Coaches Poll and were NCAA Tournament qualifiers for the 13th time.

In 1993, Krauth's Vikings were cited as the College Women's Team of the Year by the South Dakota Sportswriter's Association.

Krauth's personal honors include Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Coach of the Year (2018), North Central Conference Coach of the Year (1990), the South Dakota Sportswriters' College Women's Coach of the Year (1994), and the South Dakota Basketball Coaches Association Women's College Coach of the Year for 1989-90, 1990-91 and 2004-05.

In 2006, he was named the Russell Athletic/WBCA Division II, Region Seven Coach of the Year after leading the Vikings to a 25-7 record. Included was a school-record 20-game winning streak. In 2012, Krauth was inducted into the Sioux Falls O'Gorman High School Athletic Hall of Fame.

Teaching and coaching stints at Tri-Valley High School (Colton, SD), and Roosevelt High School (Des Moines, Iowa) preceded Krauth's Augustana appointment. He compiled a record of 347-143 as a high school coach, taking eight teams to state tournaments.
