



**Burnsville Hockey Club**  
**Gambling Report (May 2024)**

Meeting Date: May 24, 2024

*Transparency Statement:*

Gambling operations documents are maintained by the Gambling Manager and are open to the membership for review. Viewing of gambling documents can be scheduled through the either Club executive committee members or Kevin Lienau, Gambling Director. Monthly gambling documents as required by Minnesota Statute and Rule are provided to membership for voting/approval via the “Board Voting” section on the website. Voting membership is responsible for approving Monthly gambling documents.

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*Cessation of Gambling at Sites*

On April 31, 2024, the Burnsville Hockey Club Gambling operation ceased operation of charitable gambling at 3 locations (Clive’s Roadhouse, Jensen’s Café, and Bricksworth). Operation of charitable gambling was turned over to the Apple Valley Burnsville Hockey Club via their gambling entity. All revenue generation from active charitable gambling is considered concluded as of April 31, 2024.

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*License Termination Plan*

In order to close out the Burnsville Hockey Club gambling license, a License Termination Plan (Form LG204) is required to be submitted within 30 days after all gambling sales ceased. The License Termination Plan provides a plan for the final disposition of equipment as well as details how remaining funds are to be spent. A copy of the proposed LG204 License Termination Plan is posted on the website for Board review and approval.

*License Termination Plan Approval Motion:*

“I would like to entertain a motion to authorize submission of the LG204 License Termination Plan for Burnsville Hockey Club. Following approval by the Gambling Control Board, this approval also allows the Gambling Manager and/or remaining Burnsville Hockey Club officials to execute the approved plan.”

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*Expenditure Authorization:*

Club membership must give prior authorization for all gambling expenditures. Due to meeting schedule, it is not practical to authorize current month expenditures expeditiously. As such, membership is allowed to authorize an estimated expenditure up to a maximum amount. Actual expenditures must fall under this estimate and are to be reconciled via the following month’s gambling documents.

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*Allowable Expenses Motion:*

"I would like to entertain a motion to pre-approve up to, but not in excess of, \$ 45,000.00 for estimated Gambling Enterprise Operational Expenses for the month of June 2024. This pre-approval authorizes Gambling Enterprise related operational expenses as detailed on the LG1004 Gambling form under Allowable Expenses, as well as, any and all other expenses not listed that are deemed critical for the Gambling Enterprise operation."
