

Amelia Park Arena Hockey League Code of Conduct 2020-2021

Amelia Park Arena alongside game officials will strictly enforce a zero tolerance policy for all players participating in the 25+ CO-ED League and the Over 40 Men's League. Amelia Park Arena holds each player to the highest standard while participating in any program at our facility.

Disrespecting Officials or Referees

Foul language, threats, physical harm or aggressive behavior directed towards any referee or official **will not be tolerated at any level.**

If the above behavior occurs, the following procedures will take place:

First offense

- Referee will issue ONE warning to player
- If misconduct continues, the referee will ask player to exit the game and leave the ice immediately.

Second offense

- Referee will issue one warning
- If misconduct continues, the referee will ask player to exit the game and leave the ice immediately.
- Player will be suspended for an additional two games.

Third offense

- Referee will issue one warning
- If misconduct continues, the referee will ask player to exit the game and leave the ice immediately.
- The player will be suspended indefinitely.
- Should the player wish to return, the player would be responsible for setting up a meeting with Bruce and/or Christina regarding reentering the league.

Disrespecting Players

Physical harm, threats, or overly aggressive behavior directed towards any player **will not be tolerated at any level.**

First offense- ON ICE

- Referee will call the penalty and the player will be penalized according to the rule book.
- All game misconducts will be reported to Bruce/Christina and the player COULD be subject to supplemental discipline.
- If after review it is determined that there will be supplementary discipline the player will be notified in writing.

Second offense- ON ICE

- Referee will call the penalty according to the rule book.
- All game misconducts will be reported to Bruce/Christina and the player WILL be subject to supplemental discipline.

If any player is considered a habitual offender and will be dealt with more severely.

First offense- OFF ICE

- Team captain(s) will report behavior to Christina and/or Bruce.
- Christina/Bruce will give player written warning.

Second offense- OFF ICE

- Team captain(s) will report behavior to Christina and/or Bruce.
- Christina/Bruce will speak to player effected by incident.
- Christina/Bruce will decide if suspension is necessary based off communication with affected players
- Suspension would be determined after review of the incident.

Third offense- OFF ICE

The player will be suspended indefinitely. Should the player wish to return, the player will be responsible for setting up a meeting with Bruce and/or Christina regarding reentering the league.
