

ANNOUNCER / SCORER DUTIES

- Obtain team rosters and starting line-ups from coaches.
- Review pronunciation of names. If uncertain, check with a member of the respective team.
- Test the public address equipment for proper function.
- Check music source for the National Anthem (unless live music is provided).
- Announce starting line-ups.
- Request all to rise and join in singing the National Anthem
- Announce all goals scored and assists, giving player names and numbers, with elapsed time (calculate from time remaining).
- Announce penalties assessed, and when a team returns to full strength following a penalty.
- Announce when there is one minute left in a period.
- After each period, announce shots on goal for that period, and the total for the game to that point.
