



District 8 Hockey Scholarship Award

District 8 Hockey serves as MN Hockey's governing board for the southeast metro area. We take great pride in providing and managing programs that develop our young hockey players into future scholars, leaders and good citizens. This scholarship program is an investment into that mission.

District 8 Hockey awards one post-secondary education scholarship each year for current or past District 8 participants. Interested applicants should carefully read through the guidelines below.

Application Deadline is March 31 of each year.

Scholarship Eligibility, Requirements and Guidelines

1. Applicants must meet one of the following two requirements to apply:
 - a. Be a senior in good standing at a high school within the District 8 boundaries
 - b. A currently enrolled college student with active participation in D8 at the time of application.
2. Applicants must have been an active participant within D8 for at least two seasons. Applicants do not have to be active at the time of application. Participation includes player, referee, coach, volunteer, etc.
3. Applicants must have a minimum of 2.0 cumulative high school GPA (based on 4.0 scale)
4. Applicants must submit a transcript stating GPA with his/her application.
5. Applicants must submit a 700 word or less essay with application. Be sure to detail how the game of hockey has had an impact on your life.
6. District 8 Hockey Scholarship winners will be selected by the District 8 Hockey Board utilizing an independent scoring system.
7. The scoring system will weight the following categories:
 - a. District 8 Youth Hockey Involvement (10 points)
 - b. Good Citizenry (10 points)
 - c. Academics (5 points)
 - d. Financial Need (5 points)
8. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded each year; one male and one female. The District 8 Board may choose to add additional scholarships or reduce/eliminate scholarships based on available funding.
9. Awards will be onetime payments made payable to the educational institute. Winner must provide receipt of school registration to the District 8 Treasurer within one year of being awarded the grant. Scholarships are forfeited if not used within one year.
10. Scholarships are awarded at the District 8 board meeting in April and published on the District 8 website.
11. All awarding decisions by District 8 Hockey are final and not for debate or protest.
