New Business

- **Presidents Report** (Troy Domine)
 - No new information



- **Treasurer's Report** (Kris Wilke)
 - We currently have \$24,221.27 in the bank.
- **Golf Tournament Report** (Ron McCabe)
 - One golf cart was damaged during the tournament that had \$750 damage. The responsible parties involved are working with the golf course to resolve the problem and the association is not directly affected by the incident.
 - Committee will review at a future meeting on possibly setting age limits for eligible golfers, or have them accompanied by their parents.
 - Suggestion was made to raise the entry fee from \$110 per golfer to \$125. To be discussed at later meetings.
 - Ron made visits for pricing to Shoreland and LeSueur golf courses for hosting the 2025 event. Based on his findings, the committee made the decision to have the tournament at Shoreland Golf Course on July 7th 2025.
- **Coaches Report** (Chris M. & Dustin S.)
 - Chris M. made a recommendation for Boosters to pay for hotel rooms for one night for the boys team at the Alexandria scrimmage for the night of November 15th. Cost for all of the rooms to be \$2,400.75. Motion to approve made by Kris Wilke, seconded by Troy Domine, motion carried
 - Chris M. & Dustin S. made a recommendation for the Boosters to pay for half of the cost for an advanced version of Hudl which includes two 5G cameras. This allows for each team to review and make adjustments in between periods of game, game review with individualized lessons for each skater, etc. The Saint Peter School district would pay for the remaining \$2,500 for this purchase. Motion to approve made by Kris Wilke, Seconded by Amy Kamm, motion carried.
- **Miscellaneous Items**
 - Coach Buses - Matt Hathaway reported that Dean Hathaway solicited 13 different sponsors to pay for half of the cost for renting coach buses for six different away games. Games to include for both boys and girls each traveling to Luverne, Worthington & Marshall. Total cost raised to date and contribution from Boosters still to be determined based on how many sponsors can be gathered.
 - Deadline for Bulldog sponsorships is November 27th. Sponsors poster to be printed and hung at Le Sueur Community Center soon afterwards.
