



GSHSL Conduct Policy:

All players, coaches and spectators are to behave in a manner that reflects the positive fun associated with the game of basketball.

Unsportsmanlike Conduct will not be tolerated, and includes but is not limited to:

- Verbal abuse
- Arguing umpire judgment calls
- Physical aggression
- Profanity
- Tantrum-like acts

Examples of Flagrant Unsportsmanlike Conduct include but are not limited to:

- Cheating (use of an ineligible player)
- Fighting
- Repeated use of profane language, etc.

All disciplinary action will be sent to the GSHSL - Conduct Review Committee, an independent group, for review and recommendations at the completion of each weekend.

Notification of any disciplinary action may also be shared with other Minnesota Basketball Event/League operators and/or Community Leaders.

Ejection/Penalty for Unsportsmanlike Conduct

Any player, coach, manager, or spectator ejected from a game will be suspended for the following two games. These penalties may carry over to future MYAS events.

Ejection/Penalty for Flagrant Unsportsmanlike Conduct

Any player, coach, manager, or spectator ejected from a contest for flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct will be ejected for the remainder of the season and will not be permitted to remain within the facility.

Protest/Appeal Committee

The Protest Committee may review the disqualification only if the situation merits further consideration. Any ruling by the Protest Committee is final.

The Protest Committee consists of the League Directors, the Tournament Director, and the Director of Officials.
