

3 man 1 pager for Base Umps attached. I have simplified this greatly for juniors.

The attachment shows positioning. They did A, B, C positions in the Field Clinic. D is 3 man only and is the exact opposite of A position, in foul territory by 3rd base.

- A = Foul territory 1b line, B = behind 2nd baseman, C= behind shortstop, D= foul territory 3b line

The GOLDEN RULE--- you will NEVER have 2 Base Umpires in fair territory (B, C position) at the same time. One of them will always be in A or D position, sometimes both (no runners on).

1B Umpire

- A position if no runners, runner on 1B only, runner on 3B only, any other situation B position
- Fly ball to right side of outfield CF to RF 1B umpire go out, 3B umpire comes into infield and gets touches (regular 2 man)
- Fly ball to left side of outfield CF to LF 1B umpire comes into infield and gets touches (regular 2 man), 3B umpire goes to outfield for fly ball
- Any doubt, straightaway center field, then 1B Umpire goes out , and 3B umpire comes in

3B Umpire

- C position if runner on 1B only, any other situation D position
- Fly ball to left side of outfield CF to LF 3B umpire go out, 1B umpire comes into infield and gets touches (regular 2 man)
- Fly ball to right side of outfield CF to RF 3B umpire comes into infield and gets touches (regular 2 man), 1B umpire goes to outfield for fly ball
- Any doubt, straightaway center field, then 1B Umpire goes out , and 3B umpire comes in

Plate

- Same as 2 man- 1B and 3B will go out on fly balls in their areas, when they go out then you assist with base touches but stay home.
