- XIV. **Unfinished Business –**
 - a. Light Poles:

- i. Kirby Risk quoted \$51,929.78 for the lights and brackets
 - ii. Hoosier Edison Line Co quoted \$68,050.00 for the labor to install and remove all poles and lighting. Included in the estimate is labor and poles only. Old poles and wires will be left on site.
 - iii. League will provide all - Lighting equipment, wire with conduit, trenching, boxes and connectors needed.
 - iv. Need to communicate with the Lion's Club about the project as well as communicate with those who offered to volunteer their time and labor.
 - v. We can receive a loan from First Farmers Bank and Trust for \$130,000.00 - RYBL accepts this loan. DJ Butcher will sign on behalf of RYBL for the loan.
 - vi. We will pay all Kirby Risk and Hoosier Edison gets \$5,000.00 for good faith.
 - ~~vii. Musco quoted \$165k for lights. This covers material/concrete/warranty~~
 - ~~viii. J&J quoted \$46,727 Taking down old poles and wires. We have to get rid of poles. They will install new poles and run the wire down.~~

 - i. Need to still contact Clifford Signs for the Indiana American Water signs at the scoreboards
 - c. Install netting once we do the lights
 - d. moveable pitcher mound- cost? Jon emailed that information. Once we get the lights figured out, this should be our next big expense.
 - e. Reach out to Varsity for the syncing of the scoreboards issue. We need to figure out pairing and put instructions in each of the press boxes.
 - f. Find out what concessions made all season– total sales \$50,654.81 – \$23,994.04 left after expenses paid
