

NYSL All-Star Parent/Player Contract

- By agreeing to this contract, I understand and agree to the requirements outlined within this document. This signed contract shall be considered my authorization for my daughter to be considered for the 2026 Nipomo Youth Softball League All-Star team in her designated age division.
- Financial costs can potentially range from \$500 to \$1,000 per player depending on the level of tournament play achieved by a particular team; any team that qualifies for state or Western Nationals will cause the financial cost per player to potentially reach a higher cost than mentioned above. Team fundraising can help with these costs. \$100 is due at first practice. Scholarships are available, inquire on the League Website for application.
- At the individual team manager's discretion and the Nipomo Youth Softball League Board of Directors, tournaments may be scheduled for every weekend from late May through the beginning of July. If a team qualifies for the USA State or National Tournament, the season may be extended, pending USA schedule. All-Star players are expected to participate in all tournaments throughout the All-Star season that the manager has chosen to participate in.
- At the individual team managers discretion, practices may be scheduled for everyday during the week. All Star players are expected to make every reasonable attempt to participate in all team practices throughout the All-Star season.
- Participation in other activities (i.e. other sports, family vacations, etc.) that will directly conflict with an All-Star player's ability to give 100% commitment to her All-Star team could result in disqualification from team. Prior to accepting an All-Star nomination, a choice must be made by the player and parents as to which activity is most important. If All-Star softball is determined to be the most important activity and the player joins the team, full and complete participation is expected and required.
- All participants in All Stars including players, parents, and guests shall always represent Nipomo Youth Softball League and must never conduct themselves in a way that is detrimental to their reputation or identity of the league. It is understood and agreed upon that if the participant willfully disregards the established rules of the league or this policy, disciplinary action will be taken by the NYSL Board of Directors. Consequences may include, but are not limited to, elimination from All Star season and eligibility for the following season(s).
- All participants understand that the All-Star manager is solely responsible for determining players, positions, substitutes, batting order, etc. Positions played in the regular spring season does not determine the position a player will play during the All-Star season. All players are expected to support the team regardless of the amount of playing time the player may have.
- All participants in All Stars including players, parents and guests must abide by the rules of the field facilities, parks, schools, hotels, and the rules that are specific to the tournament.
- Fundraising activities that will support the team are mandatory for all participants if deemed necessary by the Manager. The Manager is not responsible for fundraising organization and planning.
- All tournaments scheduled for the All-Star season are determined by the manager and coaches of the All-Star team.
