This shrinks the board to 13 members. All board members must be registered with USA, completed SafeSport training and have a current background check done. David Bender will be working on sending out an email with everyone's status. There are currently 152 skaters registered for the upcoming season. There are some new players starting with RHA. So far there are a few play up requests that the coaches will be considering. There are 3 mite to squirt requests and one Peewee to Bantam request. Coaches will be discussing these requests at their upcoming meeting.

House Report:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The house planning committee will have their monthly meeting on 8-25-25 at 6:00. No representatives present for full report. 	
Mite Report: Michelle Valko	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Michelle requests that the coaching committee create guidelines and expectations for mite coaches. She would also like to cap the number of coaches, last season there were 17 and this was too many. Brad Eggers and Sean O'Connor will address this at the upcoming coaches meeting. They will work on setting these guidelines. There are a lot of off ice roles that parents can assist with if they do not have hockey experience. The Mite tournament has been set for March 6-8, 2026, they will need Roosevelt ice time for this tournament. 	
Strategic Planning: Brad Eggers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is some good movement being made. The next in person meeting is set for October 3rd. This is an all-day event. The team meets weekly at 7:30pm for a Zoom call, if interested in joining this call get ahold of Brad Eggers. 	
Financial Report: Sandra Weaver via email (absent today).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Statement of Activity (Profit & Loss) & Budget vs. Actual Revenue: Registration income is ahead of last year, but short of our 7% increase. This could change depending on payment plans, etc., of participants. Expenses: Nothing significant last month, the Insurance is an accrual method of accounting entry that moves the expenses over for the remaining months of the insurance term to the proper year, not necessarily what was paid out in cash for the month. No significant repairs/maintenance expenses in July. Overall net is \$75,692.61 to date. Statement of Financial Position (Balance Sheet): Cash is healthy, CDs are down due to \$100K applied to mortgage last year. Physical inventory was taken of Pro Shop items and totals approx. \$5,000. For team funds, the pre-payment of tournament registration fees has been applied to the Boys Varsity General Fund and the Squirts A/B funds (Squirts after the \$1,800 covered by RHA). Other Items: The safe is here, along with other supplies. I have a money count sheet ready to go and need to finalize the policy. Sandra would like to send this out to the Board on TeamReach prior to the next meeting for revisions/comments. All activities including concessions, admissions, fundraising, 50/50, other raffles, Scoro, Chase the Ace, and any other events handling cash will be following new procedures starting September 2025. Fundraising events will also have a report to complete for each fundraising event to ensure all revenue and expenses are properly recorded and complete. Reminder: All credit card transactions outside of a budgeted amount or recurring item will need prior approval. 	
Facilities Report: Cody Minnerath	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compressors will be turned on starting August 29th, turning on the compressors chills the floor in preparation for ice making. The back door keypad is getting worked on, replacing this could cost about \$1,500.00. Domnick Janitell is starting the process of finding someone to start training to use the computer to set up key fobs. This lock system is not internet based; someone has to be in the building to work on this program.
