



## **Scholarship Request**

Scholarships will be awarded based on financial need, academic performance, and involvement in school and community activities. In the event you have a legitimate need for financial assistance please read the Plano East Hockey Club Scholarship Guidelines carefully. The application must be filled out completely and submitted to Plano East Hockey Club President and Vice President. Plano East Hockey Club will also accept donations on your player's behalf from sources that you solicit i.e. Friends, family, employers or local businesses.

## **Scholarship Guidelines**

1. Scholarship awards will be dependent upon the financial status of the Plano East Hockey Club account used to fund the Scholarship for the forthcoming season.
2. Scholarship awards shall be limited to a maximum amount of up to 50% of the applicant's current season Player registration fee.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis.
4. A complete application must be submitted to the President and Vice President of the Board on or before the registration deadline of July 15, 2022.
5. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications for the Plano East Hockey Club Scholarship Program and will notify all applicants whether or not they have qualified for a scholarship award. The awarding of each scholarship falls solely on the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee based on each individual applicant. Award of a scholarship is independent of the roster selection process, and is not a guarantee of a roster spot.
6. In the event that a player leaves Plano East Hockey Club during the season in which a scholarship has been awarded, 100% of the scholarship award must be refunded back to the organization.
7. The complete application for the Scholarship consists of:
  - a. Personal Data
  - b. Academic Information
  - c. Extracurricular and Community Activities
  - d. Letter from parent detailing the need for the scholarship
  - e. Letter from player (not parent) containing a description of him or herself and their hockey experience.
  - f. Letter of Recommendation from previous teacher or Head Coach (non-East Hockey)
