

## **MAA Baseball/Softball COVID-19 Guidelines for Concession Stands and Restrooms**

The Merton Athletic Association (MAA) has developed guidelines for their volunteers in order to facilitate safe use of concession stands and restrooms at Pollworth and Fireman's Park. These guidelines have been developed based on Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommendations. All concessions volunteers are to review these guidelines prior to their shift. Personal responsibility remains important during this time.

### **Concessions Guidelines**

**Face Covering Requirement:** Any individual inside the concessions building is required to wear a mask per the Village of Merton mask mandate. This requirement will follow the Village mandate and will remain in place to align with other Village of Merton facilities.

**Gloves:** While handling food or payment gloves should be worn. Gloves will be provided within the concession stand.

**Hand sanitizer:** Hand sanitizer will be made available. The hand sanitizer should be placed on the stand counter so it is easily accessible to all.

**Cleaning:** Periodic cleaning of the counter should take place with provided sanitizing wipes. At the end of the night all concession spaces that were utilized should be wiped down.

**Social distancing:** If there are multiple volunteers within the concession stand they should maintain 6 feet of physical distancing. Only concession stand workers should be in the building.

### **Restroom Guidelines**

**Hand sanitizer:** Hand sanitizer and soap provided in bathrooms to ensure ability of all to prevent the spread of germs.

**Cleaning:** Concessions volunteers to use provided sanitizing wipes to wipe down all handles (door, sink, toilets) at end of each night.

**Social distancing:** Minimum of 6 feet of social distancing should be maintained while using bathroom. Anyone waiting should wait outside the bathroom facility.
