To all members of the Omaha Hockey Club,

Currently there is a TikTok trend / social media trend called “devious licks”. In this trend, kids film themselves stealing property or destroying property from public places. Popular items include soap dispensers, paper towel dispensers, toilet paper dispensers, faucet handles, etc. In addition to the thefts, people have started vandalizing property - filling toilets with toilet paper to clog them- stuffing paper towels down drains, etc. Primary targets are generally located in bathrooms where they believe cameras will not detect them.

We have been contacted by multiple rinks as they have had several instances of this theft and destruction of property over the last week. They are in no way accusing our players of this - but wanted everyone to be aware that they will prosecute to the fullest extent of the law. If they determine someone has stolen or destroyed property, they will “ban and bar” them from the property. This “ban and bar” would consequently prohibit a player from attending any OHC activity at these rinks. They would in essence, be prohibited from playing hockey. The rinks also indicated that they will be checking locker rooms and locker room bathrooms and if a team is found to be in violation the team could be ban and barred as well.
