The next registration night will be held **January 16, 2018 6-8pm** at Fishing Creek Salem Methodist Church. We are checking if Precision Lacrosse can set up that night, and if they could possibly open an online store.

Player play up requests must be submitted to the board by **March 1, 2018**. This was voted on and approved to add to the current bylaws.

It was proposed that we send out a survey to parents to get their feedback and concerns for the upcoming season.

An online store will be set up for spirit wear through Artistic Imprints. We will be doing a pre-season store that will be open for 2 weeks. This way families can have their items before the spring season begins. There will be subsequent open stores before the season and during the season. Items ship directly to customers.

It was proposed we considering switching to Mid Penn. Mid Penn plays 10 regular season games on Saturdays. Additional information is still needed to make a decision. Items needed are season start/end dates, copy of bylaws and teams available per age/grade. It was proposed to play 5 test games with Mid Penn during the regular season. Once the information is received a vote will be conducted via email.

Raphelle Beinhower is addressing the concern over players going to Mechanicsburg Lacrosse Club that attend West Shore School District. She will be contacting their President directly to discuss. She has been in contact with the Mid Penn Board President.

Coach applications/interest must be submitted by **January 20, 2018**. Potential coaches will be able to submit their interest on the website. RLLC will pay for their US Lacrosse fees of an estimated \$55.00. Any new coaches will need to submit the appropriate clearances and complete the coaching course. The coaching course includes an online section and a 3 hour in person class. A possible class coaches can attend in person is February 4, 2018 in Lancaster.

It was proposed the high school coaches meet with the 7/8th grade teams to discuss practice plans for when they move up to the high school level.

Amber will be drafting all emails that are going to parents, coaches and players. Derek and Amber will proof and coordinate in sending these out.

On **January 22, 2018** we are having another "Free New Player" clinic at Yellow Breeches from 6-7pm for both boys and girls.
