



Procedure for Appeals to the CHSAA of the Archdiocese of New York Regarding Suspensions from Game-Ejections

1. All appeals regarding game-ejections for both coaches and student-athletes must be made within 48 hours of the ejection to the President of the CHSAA of the Archdiocese of New York.
2. The appeal must be made via email. Only an athletic director or principal can make the appeal. The appeal cannot be made by a coach. A suspended coach who also serves as an administrator, i.e., athletic director or principal, cannot make the appeal.
3. The President, in consultation with the CHSAA Executive Board of the Archdiocese of New York, as well as the Chair and Assigner of the particular sport involved, will render a timely decision. Suspensions will be served if a decision cannot be rendered prior to the next CHSAA league game. Any investigation of an ejection might include witnesses and rule-interpreters specific to that sport.
4. Notification of any decision rendered will be delivered via email.
5. It is important to note that the CHSAA has the right to increase any suspension if it feels the actions of the individual(s) involved warrant further punishment.
