## What the MRCA is not:

We are NOT a branch of the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL).
We are NOT directly affiliated with FIRST or MNFIRST.
We are NOT a union.

#### More about the importance of the MRCA

As other sports in Minnesota have a national body that they align with (typically the NFHS), we have *FIRST*.

With the current association between *FIRST* and the MSHSL, the creation of the MRCA under the MSHSCA cements us as the Varsity robotics program in the State of Minnesota. This new organization now empowers coaches/mentors to approach their school district/school board with the support of two recognized bodies (MSHSL/MSHSCA).

## Organization

In our inaugural year (2018-2019), we will have an executive council of up to 8 individuals. Alex Jurek (FRC 4607, C.I.S. from Becker High School) and Becky Leuer (FRC 3038, I.C.E. from North Branch and Chisago Lakes High Schools) will act as the Executive Administrators through the 2018-19 year. During this inaugural year we currently have a preliminary constitution and will be finalizing and approving a constitution with an 8-region representative structure. These eight geographically regions will need to have a Chair and Vice Chair. We will also be working through guidelines for awards selections. Expect email updates on a regular basis.
