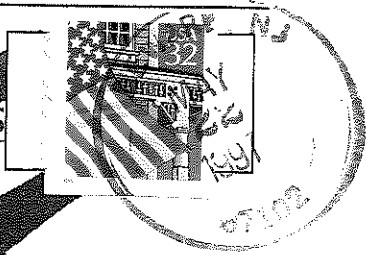

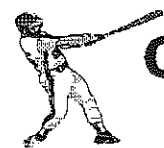

MAMA SWEEPS

MAMA'S BOYZ VS. THE FORCE- GAME 1

With a 2-6 mark, The Mama's Boyz season came down to this week. Anything but a sweep could endanger their hope of making the playoffs. 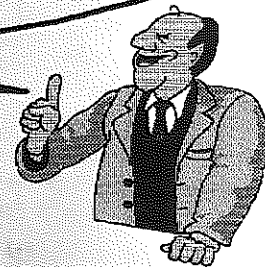
THE WHO VS. VILLAGE PEOPLE-Game 2
