

TEAM STAFF & VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

All team staff and volunteers for the Rinks, Great Park Ice, Jr Ducks, Lady Ducks, and the ADHSHL must complete the required items BEFORE participation with any team. This includes ALL Managers, Coaches, Locker Room Monitors, and any other adult staff members or volunteers with regular access to minor participants. USA HOCKEY SCREENING - must be renewed every two years

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USA HOCKEY MEMBERSHIP - must be renewed annually

- Must have current USA Hockey membership PRIOR to ANY participation
- Inline ONLY Coaches should choose the Volunteer Membership (volunteer membership is NOT applicable for Ice Coaches)



SAFE SPORT TRAINING - must be renewed annually

SCAHA PASSCODE - must be renewed annually (Jr Ducks & Lady Ducks ONLY)

- All coaches & managers must complete a concussion awareness program

COACH LEVEL	CEP AND AGE SPECIFIC MODULE REQUIREMENTS
1ST YEAR COACH	Level 1 clinic + age-specific component
2ND YEAR COACH	Level 2 clinic + age-specific component if not previously taken for current age level
3RD YEAR COACH	Level 3 clinic + age-specific component if not previously taken for current age level
4TH YEAR COACH	Level 4 clinic + age-specific component if not previously taken for current age level
