



## MILFORD ICE ARENA COVID19 PANDEMIC PROTOCOL

The rink will adhere to the “Connecticut Hockey Return to Play Rules and Guidelines”. In addition, we will follow the City of Milford’s direction and the company’s own Pandemic protocol. Please visit the [milfordice.com](http://milfordice.com) website for updates to these policies; updated 5/1/21 going forward. Please note that the safety of our customers & rink staff is of our utmost importance.

- If anyone entering the building feels any symptom of illness, the flu or has a fever, they should not come to the facility.
- Our waiver must be signed (available at [milfordice.com](http://milfordice.com) and the front desk) and applies to everyone entering the rink including Skaters, Players, Coaches, Officials, Parents and Guardians.
- Temperatures will be checked each time someone enters the arena. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° will not be allowed into the rink.
- Everyone, including coaches **MUST** wear a mask or gaiter at all times when in the rink and everyone must social distance as best as possible. *If you have a medical reason that you cannot wear a mask, you must have official medical paperwork stating such.*
- No spitting on the ice. No high fives, handshakes, hugs, etc.
- No horseplay or refusal to follow these rules.
- Dryland activities are not allowed.
- Our locker rooms **are closed** and our showers are not accessible.
- Coaches, players and skaters should enter the arena 10 minutes before their session completely dressed. No bags except for goalies (half dressed) and referees are allowed into the building.
- For all events, two parents/guardians per skater will be allowed into the building. Each can only enter at the time of the event and must leave as soon as it is over. Parents/Guardians must view the event in the designated area.
- We will be using the main entrance for entering & exiting the facility practicing social distancing directives.
- When a skater’s session has ended, each should exit the rink door one person at a time. Once the session ends, all participants should exit the facility immediately.
- Once outside, customers should proceed immediately to their car. Congregating outside the facility door or in the parking lot is strongly discouraged.
- Coaches will be responsible for maintaining social distancing of 6 feet when players are on & off the ice & when entering & leaving the ice.
- The pro shop is open to sell water bottles, skate guards, mouth guards, etc. & for skate sharpening.



- Our snack bar & water fountain are not be operational; however, the Gatorade/Water and snack vending machine will be available. Cost for the drinks is \$3.00 and the machine takes one-dollar bills and quarters. The snack machine accepts money and Apple Pay.

**Anyone violating these rules will be removed from the facility.**

**Cleaning and Disinfecting:**

- The facility will be cleaned and disinfected in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- All high touch areas will be disinfected daily.
- Hand sanitizer dispensers will be available throughout the building.
- Adequate amounts of soap and hand sanitizer will be available for customers and employees.
- Employees:
  - Employees will be instructed to stay home if not feeling well.
  - All employees will wear proper PPE.
  - Employees will receive COVID awareness training to protect themselves and our customers.
  - Temperature readings will be taken daily of all employees.
  - Employees will regularly wash their hands or use the hand sanitizers.

**Signage:** Appropriate policies and guidelines will be posted at the front entrance and inside the facility. This protocol will be posted on our web site as well.
