## F) OLD BUSINESS

- a) Conversation about rec committee to see if any interest has been generated -  
Kayleiegh & Tony advised that there has not been any so far.  
Requested to try to hit some members up to see if we can get anyone involved.
- b) Had some discussion about trying to set up a summer clinic of some sort -  
Katrina suggested to maybe do a survey to see what parents might be looking for with a clinic - She volunteered to start a draft of a survey form

- c) Updated discussion on Southington League - Chuck advised that they extended an offer to attend monthly meeting in May or June to discuss WGSA becoming involved.

d) Katrina advised that the WGSA was invited to take part in the towns Memorial Day Parade

e) Kayliegh inquired about Inhouse Uniforms status - Kris advised that the company is replacing the still missing sizes and sending them to be imprinted, hopefully this week

f) Chuck provided updates on Wakelee Fields status:

- 1) Put up new net at back of Bullpen area / Plan to install pitching mats in each lane (Chuck also advised he asked town about removing grass in bullpen and making all clay when upgrade work is done - Town advised they could do it.)
- 2) Batting cage is up & running
- 3) Fences are installed on Fields B (200 Ft) and Field C (170 Ft) - Chuck advised Field C would be moved to 200 Ft once all high school teams return to play in about 2-3 weeks - however fence could be adjusted back to 170 ft on a game to game basis for younger ages if they wanted
- 4) Chuck advised that Fields A-C -D all took water well but that Field B is very bad with water gathering
- 5) Kris advised that Snack Bar is stocked and can be used by inhouse or Travel for games if they get volunteers to run it.

## **G) New Business**

Chuck updated the Board regarding a couple parent issues that occurred this month with Travel parents violating the association code of conduct. Violations occurred on Kayliegh Goldbergs 10U team and another issue with the 12U Bauman / Johnson team. Both issues have been addressed by coaches and parents / players have been retained with the understanding that no further violations of the code of conduct can occur.
