- M.K. - 20 Oakhurst

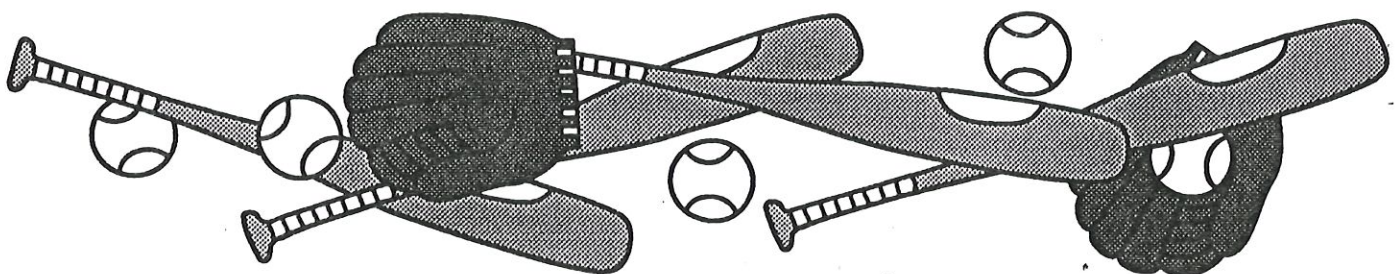
A. Well, obviously you have to be good looking and you must be a good athlete. But I think the most important thing is to clean your face 20 times a day so you can have clear, smooth skin.

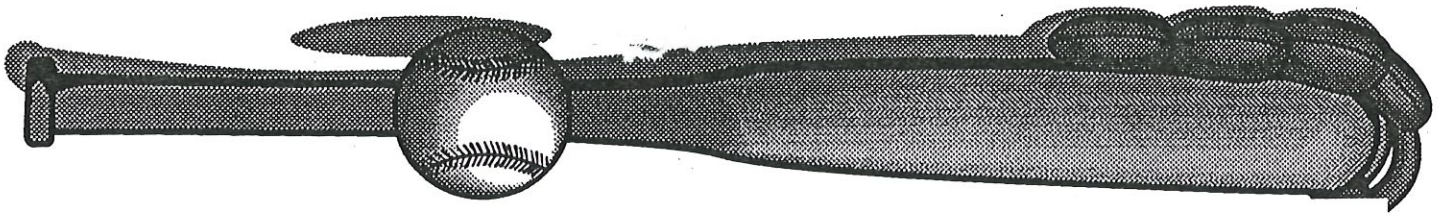

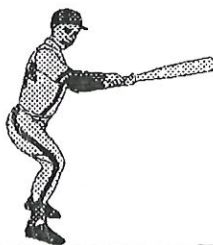
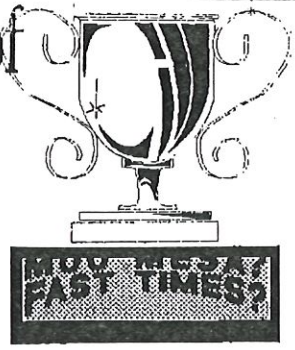
