



## Team Utah – Frequently Asked Questions



### **Who is eligible to try out for Team Utah?**

Players must be Utah residents and have a current, valid 2025-2026 USA Hockey confirmation number.

### **What level of play is this team?**

Team Utah is an advanced skill-level team. Tryouts are competitive, and roster spots are earned.

### **When are tryouts?**

April 3-4 at the Mammoth Ice Center

### **When are team practices?**

April 15, 20, 27, and possibly May 16 at varied rinks around the state.

### **Are there any required tournament weekends?**

Yes. Players must be available Mother's Day (Utah) and Memorial Day (California) weekends. Girls in Santa Clarita, CA. Youth in Irvine, CA

### **Is attendance required for all events?**

Yes. Players must be available to attend all tryouts, practices, and tournaments. This is a full commitment team.

### **Can a player participate in multiple team tryouts?**

No. Each player is limited to one team tryout.

### **What is the cost to participate?**

Tryout Fee: \$50 (Fee is due at registration and is non-refundable.)

### **Is registration open now?**

Registration will be open Tuesday, February 17

### **What happens after team selection?**

Selected players will receive full details regarding schedules, practices, tournaments, and travel expectations. All others will receive details regarding 3v3 participation. Team Fee: \$450

### **What is 3v3 and when will details be shared?**

3v3 (Three-on-Three Hockey) is a fast-paced format where three skaters per team are on the ice at a time (plus a goalie). 3v3 information will be released after the team is officially selected.
