



YOUTH BASKETBALL PLAYING TIME EXPECTATIONS

HWY 55 is a youth basketball league (not a tournament) and the intent is learning. There are two games played each Saturday and playing time is intended to be as fair as possible. See also “Factors Considered for Playing Time”.

TOURNAMENTS Coaches are encouraged to register for a number of tournaments (increasing in quantity for the older grades). The goal for tournaments is still fair playing time, however, tournaments are more competitive in nature and result in placing. This may or may not result in as fair of playing time and is more situationally dependent.

TRAVEL TEAMS Occasionally a parent or coach may choose to do post season tournament(s) (not sponsored by the Basketball Association). We love to see kids getting more experiences playing basketball, but these are not under our umbrella.

1. Attending Practices
2. Attitude (positive, team oriented, etc)
3. Sportsmanship
4. Positions

Player and/or Parent → Coach

Coach and Parent → Basketball Association Member(s)
