

# Sartell Baseball Association DIBS Requirement Policy

The Sartell Baseball Association is maintained through being a 100% volunteer organization. In order to do this, we need your help fulfilling a volunteer session, referred to as a DIBS session on our SBA website. This document is intended to clarify the DIBS volunteer requirement policy.

The following DIBS volunteer requirement applies to all Sartell Baseball Association programs except for the K-2 League (Pitchball and Rookie Ball) and Legion Baseball. The DIBS volunteer check policy applies to all CMCBL, Gopher State, and VFW players.

In order to receive your jersey/hat/apparel, the Sartell Baseball Association will need a \$500.00 volunteer deposit check. If someone else is picking up your items, you must send the deposit check with them. Please make checks payable to the Sartell Baseball Association. This volunteer deposit check is a requirement as part of the DIBS process. The DIBS process involves providing a \$500.00 deposit check to the Sartell Baseball Association, if you satisfy 8 hours (two 4 hour sessions) of volunteering through the Sartell Baseball website DIBS sessions the check will not be deposited and will be destroyed, but if you do not satisfy 8 hours of volunteering through the Sartell Baseball Association your check will be deposited as a donation to the Sartell Baseball Association. The volunteer deposit check and DIBS sessions are a requirement per family, so if you have multiple kids in baseball, only one check and one DIBS session is required. No other payment forms can be accepted, only checks payable to the Sartell Baseball Association. The only exception to providing a volunteer deposit check is if you are a Gopher State coach, CMCBL coach, or an SBA Board Member. Only three coaches per team are allowed under this exception, and the League Directors will have the final say as to who the three coaches are.
