FOOD AND BEVERAGE POLICY

Betty Engelstad Sioux Center at University of North Dakota

The Betty Engelstad Sioux Center is committed to providing a safe, clean, and positive competition environment for athletes, coaches, officials, and fans. Our food and beverage policy is designed to balance athlete performance needs, fan comfort, and facility requirements.

OUTSIDE FOOD & BEVERAGE

- Restaurant and commercially-prepared food orders, such as fast-food and take-out, are not allowed into the facility.
- Coolers, catering trays, and delivery orders are not allowed into the facility.
- ***Athletes and Teams***
 - Teams may bring nutritional snacks, water, and recovery items (fruit, protein bars, sports drinks, etc.) for athlete health and performance.
 - Coolers, crockpots, and catered meals are not allowed.
 - Exceptions may be granted for athletes with medical or dietary needs (i.e. allergies, diabetes, etc.).
- ***Fans***
 - Outside food and beverages are not allowed into the facility.
 - Exceptions may be granted for fans with medical or dietary needs (i.e. allergies, infant care, etc.).

CONCESSIONS

- Concession stands will be open during the event with food and beverage options available.
- We encourage athletes and fans to utilize our on-site concession options.
- Pricing, menu items, and hours of operation are determined by facility management.

ALCOHOL

- NCR volleyball events are alcohol-free which ensures a family-friendly and athlete-centered atmosphere. Alcohol is not permitted anywhere on the premises (i.e. facility, parking lots, etc.).

SUSTAINABILITY

- NCR volleyball encourages the use of refillable water bottles. A water bottle filling station is located in the southeast corner of the Betty Engelstad Sioux Center.
- Athletes, teams, and fans are asked to help keep the facility clean by discarding their trash in the garbage cans.
