

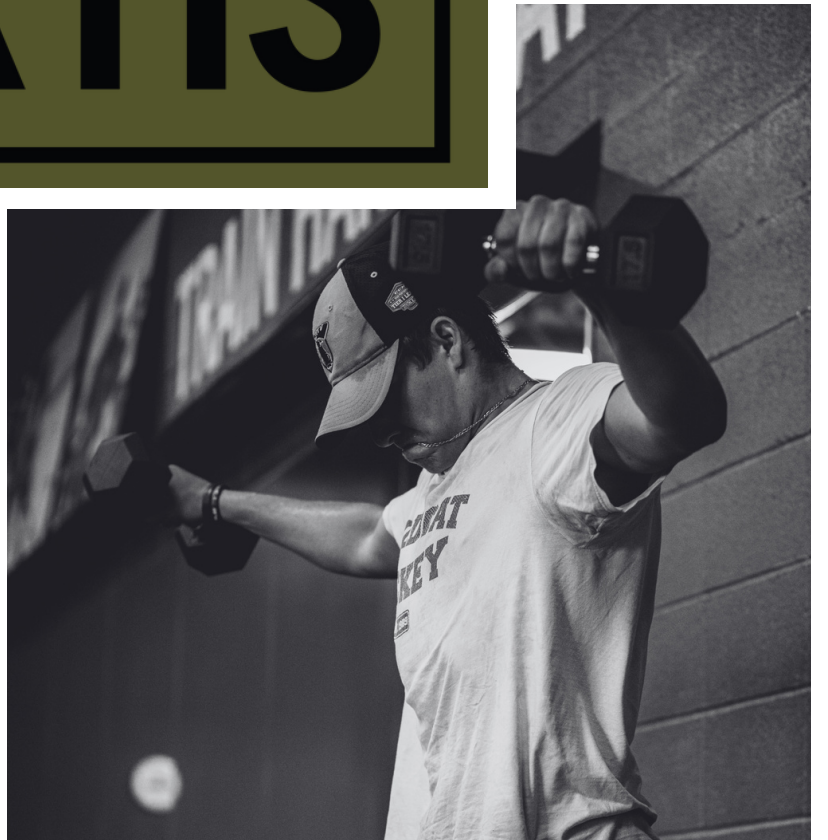

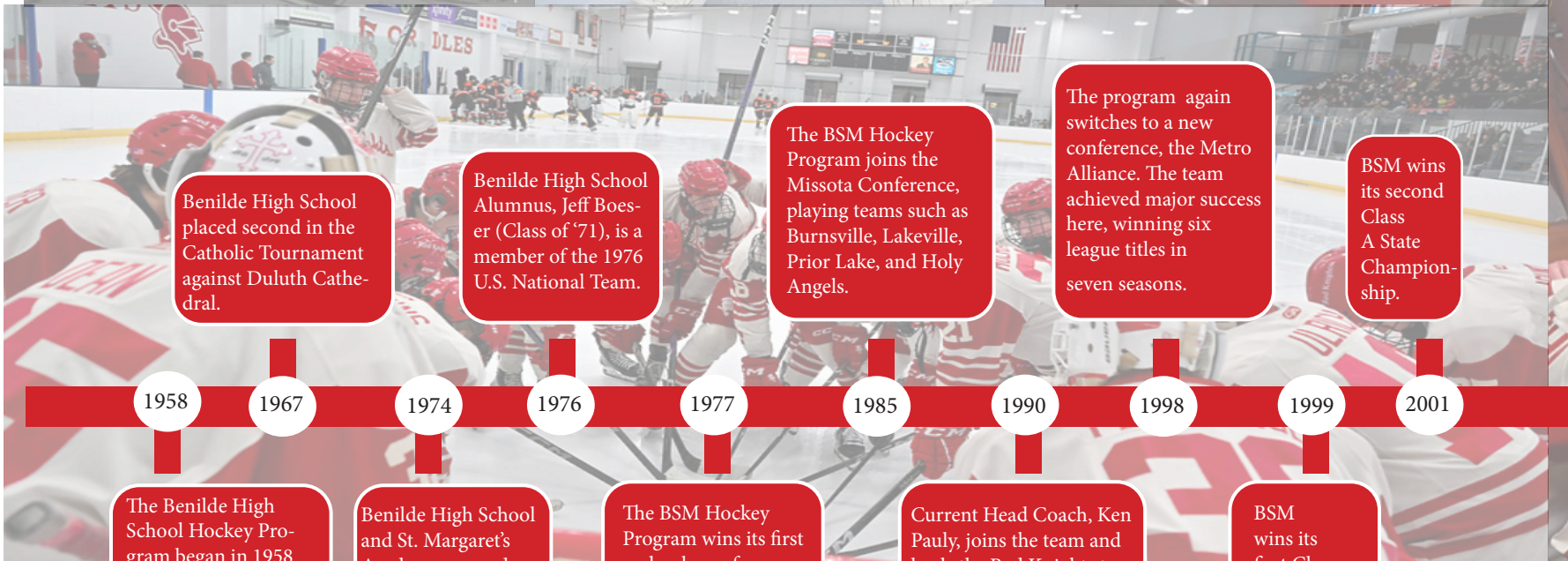

# HISTORY TIMELINE



Benilde High School placed second in the Catholic Tournament against Duluth Cathedral.

Benilde High School Alumnus, Jeff Boeser (Class of '71), is a member of the 1976 U.S. National Team.

The BSM Hockey Program joins the Missota Conference, playing teams such as Burnsville, Lakeville, Prior Lake, and Holy Angels.

The program again switches to a new conference, the Metro Alliance. The team achieved major success here, winning six league titles in seven seasons.

BSM wins its second Class A State Championship.

The Benilde High School Hockey Program began in 1958 when all practices and games were held outdoors. The first Red Knight hockey coach was Gene Sack, and they played in the Catholic Central Lakes Conference, where they won four league championships and made four trips to the Catholic State Tournament.

Benilde High School and St. Margaret's Academy merged, and the program became BSM Hockey. Along with this merger, the program switched to the Don Bosco Conference as a unified institution.

The BSM Hockey Program wins its first and only conference title in the Don Bosco Conference, when they advanced to the Region V Semifinal under the old one-class tournament.

Current Head Coach, Ken Pauly, joins the team and leads the Red Knights to win their first conference title in the Missota Conference. Under Pauly's leadership, the team saw great success, which moved the BSM Hockey Program into the upper echelon of elite Minnesota High School Hockey Programs.

BSM wins its first Class A State Championship.



# HISTORY TIMELINE

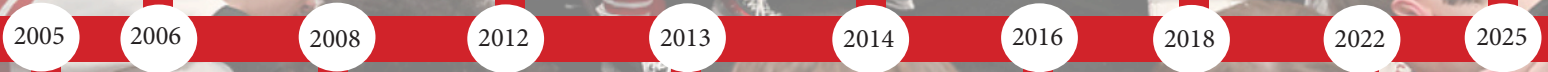
BSM jumps to Minnesota's Large-School Division, and the team kicked off the season with a big win in their first Class AA game.

BSM climbs high school hockey's highest mountain by winning the Class AA State Championship. The Minneapolis Star Tribune called one of the "most sentimental runs ever," as the team battled through a life-changing injury to player Jack Jablonski.

BSM joins the Metro West Conference, where it remains today.

BSM secures its third Metro West Title and the school's overall 21st Conference Championship. This season marked a major comeback for the team, following the graduation of most of its players the previous year.

The team gives Head Coach Ken Pauly his 600th career victory.



The team switches conferences again, this time to the Northern Suburban Conference, and goes on to collect seven straight conference titles.

After a 3-year hiatus from the team, Head Coach Ken Pauly returns to the program. The team won the Section 6AA title and went on to place 3rd overall in the State Tournament.

Grant Besse becomes the first Red Knight to be named Mr. Hockey.

BSM's first undefeated regular season. The Red Knights finished with a #1 State Ranking and 20th Conference Title.

The team gives Head Coach Ken Pauly his 500th victory as the Red Knights' Head Coach.

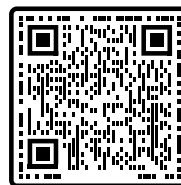

# HEAD COACH'S CORNER



Head Coach Ken Pauly has 39 years of experience coaching high school hockey under his belt. With 36 of those years coaching at BSM, Pauly has led the Red Knights to Class A State Titles in 1999 and 2001. He also took the team to its first Class AA State Tournament, claiming Third-Place Honors in 2008, and winning the Program's first Class AA Title in 2012.

During his 36 years as the Head Coach of the Red Knights, Pauly has amassed three State Titles, 17 Conference Championships, and compiled a 607-288-35 record, making him the winningest coach in the program's 62-year history, as well as ranking him 6th in career wins among Minnesota coaches, and 3rd among active coaches.

Coach Pauly is an award-winning, full-time teacher and serves as the Chair of BSM's History Department. Coach Pauly earned the school's Faculty and Staff Member of the Year Award in 2012, the Red Knight Leadership Award in 2015, and was chosen as BSM's commencement speaker in 1997 and 2018. Coach Pauly also received the 20 Years of Service Honor as a faculty member.

Coach Pauly earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History from the University of Minnesota in 1989. He and his wife, Anne Marie Dominguez, an English teacher at BSM, reside in Plymouth and have two children who graduated from BSM: Caroline (Class of 2019) and A.J. (Class of 2018).

# THE COACHES



## **Derrick Raymond - Varsity Assistant Coach and Hockey Operations Director**

Assistant Coach and Hockey Operations Director Derrick Raymond is beginning his 11th season with the Red Knights. Coach Raymond handles analysis and various other duties related to team operations. Before joining the Red Knights, he served for six years on staff at Robbinsdale Cooper High School, and currently serves on the Player Development Committee for the Armstrong-Cooper Youth Hockey Association. Coach Raymond resides in New Hope with his wife, Jessica, and their four children, and works for Johnson Paper, a division of Dacotah Paper.

## **Grant Besse - Varsity Assistant Coach**

Grant Besse, BSM alumnus and 2013 Mr. Hockey Award winner, has returned to the program to coach the team's forwards and power-play unit. While he attended BSM, Besse excelled in both hockey and baseball. Besse led the hockey team to a 5-1 victory in the 2012 State Championship, scoring all five goals. Besse holds BSM's record for most career goals and the record for most career points; additionally, Besse holds 3rd place for career assists at BSM. After his high school career, Besse went on to play for the University of Wisconsin, where he led the Badgers hockey team in scoring in 2016 and 2017, before going on to a five-year professional hockey career.



## **Grant Holler - Goaltending Coach**

Grant Holler is entering his sixth season as the Red Knight goaltending coach. Coach Holler played two seasons in the NA3HL, where, during his rookie season with the Granite City Lumberjacks, he helped them to a NA3HL championship. Following his time with the Lumberjacks, he played for the Breezy Point Northstars before attending the University of St. Thomas, where he studied Business Law and Spanish Linguistics. Coach Holler brings additional experience from his time as an intern at Bandits Goalie School in Michigan, CrossFit Fast Factory in St. Cloud, and being the lead goalie instructor at Fortis Academy, a position he has held since 2019. Coach Holler works as a product manager in the financial services industry and resides in North-East Minneapolis with his wife, Rachel, and their two dogs.

## **Danny Charleston - Varsity Defense Coach**

Danny Charleston returns to his alma mater for a second time as an assistant coach. He was an assistant coach for the 2011-12 team, which won the Class AA state championship. After spending the 2011-12 season as a member of the Red Knight staff, Charleston took over as boys' head coach for Armstrong for two seasons, and then took the helm as the AC Wings coach for 11 seasons when Armstrong and Cooper merged. During his tenure, he amassed 131 wins in 13 seasons. A member of BSM's 2001 Class A state championship team, Charleston tallied 20 goals and 42 points. He would go on to play four seasons in the USHL, where he scored 42 goals and 131 points in 170 games. He went on to play four seasons at the University of Nebraska-Omaha, where he scored 43 goals and 116 points in 159 games. He played parts of three seasons professionally, playing 12 games in the AHL and 57 games in the ECHL, recording 18 goals and 66 points in 57 career games. Two of his professional seasons saw him as a member of the New Jersey Devils' organization.



## **Craig Roberts - Director of Communications/Statistics and Analytics**

Beginning his 20th season with the Red Knight Hockey Program, Craig Roberts is continuing to fill his vital role as the program's director of Communications/Statistics and Analytics. Mr. Roberts manages the team's website, handles media requests, compiles statistics and analytical data, and works closely with event management. Mr. Roberts has worked on the sports information staff for various universities and has contributed to other BSM athletics programs. Mr. Roberts graduated from Minnesota State University in 1997 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Mass Communications. Mr. Roberts is employed by Appliance Products Co. and resides in Marshall, WI.

## Tanner Grina - Varsity Assistant Coach

JV Assistant Coach Tanner Grina is beginning his 8th season coaching high school hockey, and his 5th season with the Red Knights. Coach Grina graduated from the University of North Dakota with a Bachelor's Degree in Exercise Science with a minor in Coaching, and received his Master's in Sport Psychology from Minnesota State University, Mankato. Before joining the Red Knights, Coach Grina served as an assistant coach at Mankato East High School from 2015-2018, where he helped lead them to the State Tournament. After his 3 years at Mankato East, he moved on to become the Bantam AA Head Coach for Lakeville South, where he led them to the State Tournament in 2019 and 2020, before moving on to become an assistant coach for the Eden Prairie Bantam AA team, where he helped lead them to the State Tournament in 2021. Coach Tanner has also served as a head coach in the Minnesota Elite Prep Development League for the past six years. Coach Tanner works for SPS Commerce as a Sales Operations Analyst and resides in Brooklyn Park with his wife, McKensie, and their two sons.

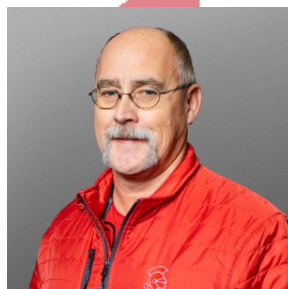
## Chris McGowan - JV Head Coach

JV Head Coach Chris McGowan, a BSM alumnus from the class of 1991, is returning for his 19th season as a coach for the Red Knights' JV program, leading the team to an impressive 280-125-34 record. While McGowan attended BSM, he was a three-sport athlete playing hockey, soccer, and tennis. McGowan attended St. Mary's University, where he was a star soccer player, and graduated with a bachelor's degree. After attending St. Mary's, he went on to earn his MBA from Babson College's School of Business. McGowan works for Staples, Inc., where he serves as a managing director in their Healthcare and Strategic Accounts department, and resides in Victoria with his wife, Jane, and their two children.



## Dave Liebrez - JV Assistant Coach

JV Assistant Coach Dave Liebrez is beginning the 18th season of his second stint with the Red Knight Hockey team. Previously, Coach Liebrez helped found and coach the BSM Bantam program before he joined Coach Pauly's staff in 1992. Coach Liebrez then followed Pauly to Minnetonka and returned to BSM along with Pauly in 2007. Coach Liebrez is an alumnus of Wayzata High School (Class of 1978) and was a three-sport athlete with the Trojans, playing hockey, soccer, and baseball. Coach Liebrez played hockey for Gustavus Adolphus College, where he graduated in 1982 with a Bachelor of Arts degree with a double major in psychology and business. Coach Liebrez is a member of the American Production and Inventory Control Society and the Institute for Supply Management, holds several professional certifications, and currently resides in Plymouth.



## Chet Skinner - JV Assistant Coach

JV Assistant Coach Chet Skinner is beginning his first season with the Red Knight hockey team. Coach Skinner is an alumnus of Gentry Academy, where he played as a defenseman and was a member of their 2021 Class A State Championship squad, and went on to play one season with the Tampa Bay Juniors in the USPHL. Coach Skinner works for Fortis Academy and Edina Realty, and currently resides in St. Paul.
