

# 2022 Health Guidelines

## 7 Elite Academy International Tournament



Please Note: Right of Admission & Participation is Reserved, based on the following requirements:

- Mask must be worn by all players, coaches, spectators, and staff at all times.
  - This includes while coming and going from the fields.
  - Exception - Players actively playing on the field – Players must wear mask while on bench. Coaches must also wear masks.
- No congregating policy applies to all players, coaches, etc. in drop off zones, parking lots, entrances/exits of the fields.
  - Teams and Spectators are expected to exit quickly, without delay, to allow next teams and spectators to take the field.
- Team Managers/Coaches should ensure all coaches & players sanitize hands before taking the field and again at halftime. All substitutes entering and leaving the field during the game.
  - Sanitizer is available for purchase at cost located at headquarters.
- Team Managers/Coaches should check symptoms of all players before taking the field. Anyone with Covid-19 (“the Disease”) related symptoms will not be allowed to play/take the field.
- There will not be handshakes, high fives before or after game/s. Players are encouraged to clap for opposing teams/spectators.
- Signage will be posted reminding players, coaches, and spectators to physically distance.
- Players, coaches, referees, staff/volunteers will be required to bring their own water bottle. No sharing of water bottles is permitted.
- Team benches and shared equipment such as game balls must be sanitized before and after use.
- “Home” team to provide sanitized games balls to the referees.
- Any high-risk individuals or those directly or indirectly exposed to Covid-19 should not play or attend and may be excluded from participation.
- Spectators allowed with conditions:
  - Those in different households must be physically distanced – 6ft minimum.
  - Spectators must remain a safe distance off the sidelines.
  - Tournament Staff have authority to direct compliance with all health policies. Those who refuse will be asked to leave the premises.
