

## Start Times

League matches begin promptly at 7:00 pm.

Plan accordingly regarding traffic and travel time.

If you think you will be late, it is your responsibility to notify either someone on your team or the other team and let them know you are on your way.

## Match Formats

The standard league format has six players participating from each team. The top skill players are expected to play in the top slots.

If a team cannot field a full compliment of six players:

- Team A can't field six players. Team A captain contacts Team B captain with adequate notice (i.e. prior to noon on the day of the match). Team B captain shall decide whether to do option A (12 pts for doubles, 9 pts for #1 singles, 7 pts for #2 singles, 5 pts for #3 singles), or option B (12 pts for #1 doubles, 12 pts for #2 doubles, 9 pts for singles).
- As usual, if Team A does not provide adequate notice to Team B (after noon on the day of the match), Team A is penalized 5 points.

### Handballs:

Each team to provide two balls, one for each regular season match.
