



KYSA August Meeting 8/13/20

EPYSA fee schedule:

- Sept 15th deadline to enter teams - \$250 fine if after that date
- Insurance coverage is good if season occurs

PIAA is having a meeting next Friday 8/21/20 regarding the resumption of fall sports. The governor has made the recommendation to cancel all sports until January 2021. If PIAA decides to cancel fall sports, KYSA will also shut down for the season.

KYSA has decided to open non-fee registration sometime next week (8/18 or 8/19?) and close on 8/26. On the site will include COVID protocols, potential fee schedule (\$20 across the board) and the date that charges will incur. Registration numbers will be monitored and shared continuously throughout registration process to help determine viability and potential team sizes and numbers.

General consensus was that U6/U8 would need 24 athletes making 4 teams of 6 players. The season would run like a typical round robin scenario. Concern was verbalized if the numbers fall off as season progresses as they normally do. Alternate scenarios will have to be discussed and planned. The same issue presents itself with older age groups. Potential smaller team sizes and co-ed option may be needed.

Proposed season would last 8 weeks, running from September 11th/12th into October 31st/November 1st. Practice schedule will be limited and TBA.
