

Figure Skating Club of Bloomington Associate Coach Agreement

In consideration for the privilege of being an Associate Coach with the Figure Skating Club of Bloomington (FSCB), I, the undersigned, have full understanding and take full responsibility for and agree that I will abide by all Rules and Regulations of the FSCB, including the following:

1. I understand that my associate coaching agreement is valid for 1 year. I will submit updated paperwork each membership year.
2. I am a full member of PSA and abide by its CODE OF ETHICS.
3. I will carry liability insurance (with PSA, USFS or ISI) and provide proof of coverage to FSCB. Without liability insurance, I understand that I will not be allowed on any ice sponsored by FSCB.
4. I will not use, or be under the influence of drugs, alcohol or other mind altering or motor skill impairing substances while involved in and around FSCB contracted ice.
5. I will encourage my students to pay all fees owed to FSCB.
6. I will follow all safety rules of the FSCB and the City of Bloomington and will direct my student skaters to do the same.
7. I will encourage harmony, goodwill and ethical behavior among the skaters, parents, coaches and rink personnel inside and outside of the rink. I will always promote FSCB in a positive manner at Bloomington and elsewhere.
8. As a professional, I will support all FSCB activities.
9. I will dress and behave in a professional manner at all times.
10. Solicitation of any FSCB member will not be tolerated.

FSC OF BLOOMINGTON ASSOCIATE COACH QUALIFICATIONS

The Figure Skating Club of Bloomington considers it a privilege to be associated with the club and it's members. As such, FSCB holds those associated with the club to the highest standards. Associate Coaches may coach on FSCB club ice 3 or less days per week. For the position of Associate Coach, the minimum requirements are as follows.

1. Qualified to coach as represented by one or all of the following:
 - Professional figure skating coach for a minimum of 5 years and active in PSA's continuing education program.

 - Mentored by an FSCB coach for a minimum of 6 months or 30 hours and receive recommendation to apply as an associate coach.
2. Recommended for the position by majority of the active FSCB Home Club Coaches.
3. A full member in good standing with PSA and abide by its code of ethics.
4. Submission of the following to the FSCB Board of Directors for review:
 - Letter requesting recognition as an Associate Coach
 - Current resume
 - signed FSCB Associate Coach Agreement
 - Copy of USFS, PSA or ISI Liability Insurance Policy
 - Confirmation of USFS Coaches Registration

Upon receiving your application packet, the Board will schedule a review at an upcoming Board meeting. The Board will contact you to inform you of the following

- More information is required to consider your request.
- Your qualifications did not meet one or more of the requirements.
- Your application has been accepted and the date you will be considered an Associate Coach.
