

# Eddie Radwanski

All-American player; MLS  
player; University Head Coach



**Eddie Radwanski** served as the Head Coach of Women's Soccer at UNCG from 2001 to 2010. During his tenure the Spartans won 11 Southern Conference championships, 7 regular season and 4 tournament titles. They advanced to 5 NCAA tournament appearances. Eddie's record at UNCG was 139-65-13. Since 2011 he has served as the Head Coach of Women's Soccer at Clemson. His 2016 team was the ACC champion and advanced to the Sweet Sixteen of the NCAA tournament. His 2014, 2015 and 2017 teams also advanced to the NCAA tournament. Eddie has effectively reinstated the program to a level of ACC and national relevancy. His current record at Clemson is 70-47-18 thus bringing his overall record as a Division I head coach to 209-112-31.

Born in Neptune, New Jersey Eddie matriculated at UNCG in 1981 after his high school team had won the New Jersey State Championship in his senior year. At UNCG he played on 2 Division III National Championship teams under Coach Mike Berticelli, 1982 and 1983. Eddie played his senior season under Coach Michael Parker. He became UNCG's first two-time All American for his play during his junior and senior seasons.

Chosen the first overall player by the then Dallas Sidekicks in the MISL 1985 draft Eddie played on the 1986 and 1987 MISL Championship teams. From 1990-1992 he played for the Tacoma Stars and was named their MVP in 1992. From 1985-1992 he was also a member of the US National team making 5 starts. In 1993 Eddie moved back to Greensboro as a member of the USISL Dynamo. The Dynamo won the 1993 and 1994 USISL National title with Eddie being named the League MVP and the National Finals MVP in 1993. The Dynamo were again National finalists in 1997. Most significantly, it was during this time when he finally achieved a long standing commitment to the UNCG athletic administration by completing his undergraduate degree in business.

He served as head coach and coaching director for the GSO Twister organization from 1997-99; the Piedmont Spark in 1999; the NC ODP state team head coach 2002-2009 and the Region III ODP head coach from 2002-2009.

Eddie's playing success has been recognized by his induction into 4 athletic Hall of Fames: UNCG Charter Class 2000, (the 1982 and 1983 UNCG teams in 2004 and 2009), Neptune HS, 2012, Guilford County, 2018 and the Carolina Dynamo. He was the MVP in the 1984 Collegiate Senior Bowl. He was also named first team All Decade for the 1980's and All-Century Team for New Jersey by the Newark Star Ledger.

He has been the recipient of 6 Coach of the Year recognitions: 2006, 2007 and 2008 in the Southern Conference, 2016 in the ACC, and 2010, 2015 as the Southeast Region Division I Coach of the Year.

An active and productive team player, coach and mentor to his student athletes; Eddie Radwanski has been a winner in all of his soccer pursuits. His personal commitment to the welfare of his student athletes is best demonstrated by his UNCG and Clemson teams consistently leading their entire athletic programs academically.
