

All-Star Season Information





General Information

- All-Stars is considered a second season and there are separate fees to play All-Stars.
 - Fees are set by the board depending on Tournament Prices, Uniforms and other additional costs.
 - Teams which advance to State, Regional and/or National Championship will have the registration cost for the tournament paid from the General League Fund.
- Uniforms (3 jerseys, 2 pairs of pants) are covered by part of the registration fees.
 - Uniforms will be ordered as soon as teams are formed, so it is very important that all players complete jersey try on at tryouts.
- Practices will be limited to a maximum of 4 times per week and a maximum of 3 hours per practice.
 - Applies to “optional” or “non-mandatory” conditioning and/or practices.
- The Board of Directors decide which tournaments the All-Star teams will participate in.
 - “Silver” and “Bronze” teams will participate in “Silver” and “Bronze” Tournaments (if applicable) and attend “C” Districts (if USA Softball district commissioner approves and there is room in the “C” district tournament)



Manager Eligibility & Selection

- Any staff of a Rancho Cucamonga ACE Softball team who are eligible.
 - You may apply to be an All-Star Manager if you did not manage a team this season.
 - Eligible managers and staff must have completed a background check and SafeSport Clearance
 - 2 (two) managers and coaches per team need to be USA SOFTBALL "A.C.E. Certified" in accordance with USA Softball USA SOFTBALL rules to be selected to manage an all-star team.
- The All-Star Committee will interview and vote on the All-Star Manager.
- A proctor will be assigned to moderate the All-Star Manager interviews.
 - The proctor shall be the division coordinator or a non-biased member of the board (i.e., does not have a player in that division).



Team Formation

- All-Star Tryouts are only for the 8 – 14U divisions.
- 6U Managers will discuss and vote for all 6U All-Star teams.
- All-Star rosters shall consist of a team with a minimum of 11 players and maximum of 12 players.
 - The number of players on a roster is based on manager discretion.
- Any additional All-Star teams must have proper player skill support to be League Sanctioned.
 - The “Gold” team must be comprised of the best players of their respective division.
 - “Silver” and “Bronze” teams may only be assembled after the “Gold” team is completely assembled.
- Managers are given individual ballots for All-Star voting.
- The manager who attended the try-out may attend the “All Star” selection meeting, but only one ballot per team will be allowed.
 - No proxy voting is permitted.



Team Formation

- Votes are tabulated and ranked using a point system.
 - Players are ranked based on points received; rankings determine All-Star selection.
 - Managers rank players on their ballots (e.g., from 1 to the number determined by the All-Star committee).
 - Scores are assigned based on the rankings.
 - Player scores from each manager are averaged with the overall score determining the player's combined ranking.
 - Once ballots are tabulated, the list is sorted by combined ranking.
 - Scores are confidential and will not be released.
 - In the event the All-Star manager chooses to roster 11 players then the first 7 players will be chosen through the voting process and the All-Star Manager will choose 4 players from the next 15 that received votes. The manager may be given an opportunity to choose 1 player outside of the 15 on a case-by-case basis.
 - In an All-Star Roster of 12 players the managers will choose the first 8 players through the voting process. The All-Star Manager for that division will then choose the following 4 players from the 30 Rev. 1.5.2025 next 15 who received votes. The manager may be given an opportunity to choose 1 player outside of the 15 on a case-by-case basis.
- Committee Oversight:
 - The board committee reviews all ballots and Managers who appear to misplace or omit a player compared to other voters may be privately questioned.
 - Justification for rankings is required; adjustments may be requested if substantiation is inadequate.
- Tiebreaker Rules:
 - Rankings are first broken by:
 - Number of votes in the top ten (or top twenty for a second team).
 - Number of times a player appears on a ballot.
 - If still deadlocked, the committee decides the tie.



Player Eligibility

- Any Rancho Cucamonga ACE Softball player who has played a minimum of 75% of their current Rancho ACE Spring season games that are used to determine the standings within the league are eligible.
 - A documented injury will be an exception to this rule.
 - Players participating in two recreational leagues are not eligible to play Select or All-Stars with Rancho Cucamonga Ace Softball.
- Any Player who plays or participates* with a travel ball team or a team outside Rancho Cucamonga ACE Softball after March 31st is automatically ineligible for All-Stars.
 - **NOTE: "Participates" in the above is defined as – A player taking part in any try out, practice, practice game, scheduled game, tournament or clinic hosted or affiliated with a travel-based organization.*
- Players do not have a choice on which All-Star team they play on.
 - All interest is for the "Gold" team.
 - Players may state interest to play on "Silver" and "Bronze" teams via the player interest form should additional teams become available.



Player Eligibility

- Players are eligible in their age-appropriate division, not their petitioned division.
 - Players who are already “playing up” may petition to “play up” in All-Stars provided the following criteria are met:
 - Played and completed at least 75% of two regular seasons (Fall and/or Spring) in the petitioned division.
 - Participate in All-Star assessments for both the age-appropriate division and the petitioned division.
 - Be eligible by being either:
 - Voted in.
 - Selected by the All-Star manager.
 - Only **two** players who petition up may make a “Gold” All-Star team.
 - All other players must meet the age requirements for their respective divisions.
 - Approval from the board of directors is required.
 - If this condition is not met, eligibility is limited to their age-appropriate division.
- Players who signed a "no pitch" agreement for the regular season are ineligible to pitch in any All-Star games.



Additional Information

- Any player who discloses they will not be in attendance for any portion of the all-star season will still be eligible to tryout.
 - Selection to the team will be at Manager discretion
- If a player resigns and/or quits from the commitment made to the team after being selected, she will not be eligible for any future All-Star and or Select Teams for at least one calendar year.
