



QCHA Fundraising Policy Effective 8/2024

All team fundraisers have to be approved **prior** to initiation or items being bought by the Director at Large, Community Engagement (director1@quadcityhockey.com). If it is a raffle, include the draw date. Raffles need to be drawn within 4 weeks of the initial start date.

When the fundraiser is approved, a form will be sent to the team manager that needs to be filled out, including expenses, and revenue generated. This will need to be sent back to the director at the end of the fundraiser.

There is a limit of 1 type of fundraising being run per team at a time. For example: Squirt Travel does a basket raffle, another team needs to wait until theirs is drawn to start.

No pictures of alcohol can be used for fundraising and in social media posts. Please see the QCHA policy regarding alcohol.

Prohibited items:

- Homemade items with QCHA, Blues or Lady Blues logo
- Items that compete with QCHA spirit wear sales
