



## COVID-19 TOURNAMENT PROTOCOL 2021

The State of Illinois Region 2 has recently been moved to Bridge Phase which allows us for a little more participation for our tournaments. The following are some prophylaxis that we will follow to perform due diligence to protect spectators, players, & coaches. The following protocol is in place to benefit everyone. Please help us to continue to allow the girls to keep playing volleyball. We understand everyone is experiencing Covid fatigue, but if we all work together, we can continue to compete.

- 30 Minutes between waves, teams should not show up more than 30 minutes before their assigned to play.
- Masks are Required for all Spectators, Officials, ScoreKeepers, Players, and Coaches. Waivers are provided for those with a Signed Medical Release from a Physician with the reason for Medical Waiver. Waivered Spectators Must social distance from other spectators. Waivers are, however, allowed for spectators that are fully vaccinated and have achieved the required 14 dates after their final shot.
- We Highly Encourage social distancing of all spectators
- There is a limit of 4 spectators per player.
- Only 3 people are allowed for Score Keeping (parents will be Required for current scheduled playing teams). No line judges, or down officials will be used.

Coaches that sign the JVA Coaches Sign-in Form, also acknowledge that the above Covid-19 Protocol will be followed by their players and spectators.
