- 1. The Coach promises during the term of his agreement, that he will instruct the disciplines of football as specified under the rules and bylaws of the New England Youth Tackle Football Inc. The Coach agrees to participate in all practices, and in all league and exhibition games scheduled by the Club.
- 2. The Coach further agrees that he will conduct himself in a respective manner at all times as a representative of the Club and of the New England Youth Tackle Football Inc. If, in the opinion of the Club or the officers of the New England Youth Tackle Football Inc., the Coach acts in a manner contrary to such obligation, either the Club or the said league shall have full power and authority to unilaterally terminate this agreement and deny the Coach any right to coach football on such Club in such league.
- 3. The Coach agrees that he will assume all risks of coaching tackle football, which he recognizes as a high-speed, physical contact sport, and further agrees to release and save harmless both the said Club and said New England Youth Tackle Football Inc., and/or their respective officers, coaches, directors and staff. Accordingly, the Coach hereby waives any claim against any of the above parties for any type of injury or harm or loss which Coach may be caused to suffer in connection with any activity in connection with Coach's involvement to any extent or in any capacity with said Club or said League. Coach further agrees to release any city, town, municipality, institutions both public and private and any representatives thereof, including but not limited to, parties in control of stadiums and facilities, and similarly waives any future claim he may have against any such party. The Coach is assuming (i.e., voluntarily exposing himself) to certain known and appreciated health risks and physical dangers inherent to coaching tackle football, about which risks and dangers Coach hereby represents his awareness and appreciation.
- 4. The Coach shall not write or sponsor any magazine or newspaper articles concerning the Club or the League, nor shall Coach endorse any product or service without written consent from the New England Football League or the Club.
- 5. In order to ensure that all participants have the benefit of a safe and fun learning environment, all parents, guardians and other adults and attendees of NEYT events must behave accordingly in a respectful, courteous and sportsmanlike manner at all times. It is understood that any incident considered detrimental to the pursuit of this ideology will not be tolerated. It will be addressed in accordance with the statutes of NEYT, state and local laws, and may result in dismissal from the program and the inability to participate in any future related activities of the association.
- 6. I agree to assume full responsibility for any and all equipment & uniforms loaned and I agree to promptly return, upon request, the uniform and other equipment issued in good condition as when received except for normal wear and tear. If I fail to adhere to this policy, I will be responsible for the full replacement cost of such equipment.

Background Check Policy

It is critical that all volunteers associated with New England Youth Tackle Football be processed in a way that promotes the highest possibility of child safety. It is the policy of NEYT to require all volunteer Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches associated with any NEYT youth sport or activity to be processed in accordance with this policy. All volunteers must complete an annual background screening. Any Head Coach or Assistant Coach who does not complete the background criminal record check process will not be allowed to volunteer for any NEYT activity. To make the process easy and accessible NEYT has partner up with the National Center for Safety Initiatives (NCSI) to conduct the screening. No other form of background screening will be accepted.

USA Football Heads Up Certification

At NEYT the safety of our children is paramount. ALL HEAD COACHES, ASSISTANT COACHES, GMS and TEAM MOMS need to be Heads Up Certified through USA Football. Proof of completion is required to receive a badge to access the sidelines of games. Be sure to print your certificate as proof of completion and have it with you at the official certification session. USA Football has modified the process of getting coaches heads up certified. Promotion codes are no longer used to get the discounts and won’t be provided as in previous years.

Center For Disease Control (CDC) Concussion Training.

By taking this free, online course and using what you learn, you will be well positioned to improve the culture of concussion. Your actions can help create a safe environment for young athletes so that they can stay healthy, active, and thrive – both on and off the playing field. Proof of completion is required to receive a badge to access the sidelines of games. U.S. CENTER FOR SAFE SPORT - SAFE SPORT ACT

The U.S. Congress designated the U.S. Center for SafeSport with the authority to respond to reports of sexual misconduct within the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Committee by passing the Protecting Young Victims from Sexual Abuse and Safe Sport Authorization Act of 2017. This legislation also known as S.534, designates the Center to serve as the *independent* national safe sport organization, with the additional responsibility for the Center to develop national policies and procedures to prevent the emotional, physical, and sexual abuse of amateur athletes. Through this legislation, the Center has the exclusive authority to respond to allegations of sexual abuse and sexual misconduct within the U.S. Olympic & Paralympic Committee. It also allows the Center to have discretionary jurisdiction on a case-by-case basis over any other forms of misconduct, including bullying, harassment, and physical and emotional abuse.
