USAH

SECRETARY'S REPORT

- Minutes from the August meeting were approved. Motion to approve by Jeff Dzubinski, seconded by Jim Rearic.

TREASURER'S REPORT

- \$100,000 savings
- 105,174.49 checking
- Final billing going out tomorrow on the per player installments.
- All of the accounts for the leagues will be reconciled tomorrow.
- Fines will be posted for fines accounts mainly for scoresheet infractions.
- Working with the accountants and taxes will be finalized at the end of the month.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

- Grateful that we are moving forward with season, still have some challenges leaking over from Covid, done good job to push forward to get placement games done and get scheduling done. Got some games under our belts for the season and commend everyone for the work that was done to get this season to get us where we are and to continue to moving forward.

PAHL STANDING REPORTS:

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

- Grow the Sport Award
 - 1 application for Beaver, would like to extend the deadline to end of October for award application. Application are under PAHL Info on the website.
- SportsEngine System Scoring System has not picked up on the change in penalty minutes yet so managers need to go by what's on the scoresheet not what's in the system for assigning fair play points until the systems gets figured out.
- Hunt Armory system is currently set up to request ice time. Information will be sent out to club presidents. If you want a PAHL game, you must follow all PAHL game rules.
- National Bound Teams, all payments needs in if you want to play by their meeting in the first week in December.

SCHEDULING

- 2/3 of the way through squirt scheduling, only missing 2 games, going smoothly and yes teams will be moved based on results we are seeing.

DISCIPLINE

- Every carryover suspension from last year has been satisfied outside of one player who has until December 31st to serve his suspension who is not with an organization yet and two have aged out. Everyone else has served their suspensions that are on a roster to play this year.
- 128 Misconducts/matches so far
 - 5 match penalties -1 slur/ 2 helmet removal
 - Slur-hearing
 - Other 4 offered plea bargain (going rate was 3-5 games in lieu of a hearing speeding up the process)
- General misconduct
 - Fighting leading penalties cause
 - 19 coach suspensions (new 12 penalty rule)
 - 26 players with 4 penalties in one game

SAFETY REPORT

- 21 teams have been quarantined and another 10 or 12 team asking questions.
- Call if you have questions to keep everyone safe and sound.

OLD BUSINESS

- 10U or 12U games, can they be refereed by single referees. Non-checking games can be done by a single referee.

NEW BUSINESS
