

**Taylor High School Athletic Booster Club Board
General Meeting Minutes from November 7, 2022.**

President Brad Ingram called the meeting to order at 6:29 p.m. from the THS 9th Grade Cafeteria. Becca Wolfgang was appointed to take minutes. There were 13 members present, including 1 parents, 6 coaches and 6 officers who signed in. Copies of the October meeting minutes were approved and are available on the website.

Officer Reports:

President: Brad – welcomed and thanked everyone for coming.

Treasurer: Michael – October financials will be available on the website.

VP Fundraising: Brad reported for Connie. Spirit Nights at Red River - \$95 (10%, best one yet), Cook Shack - \$74, Trivia Night – over \$10,391 in revenue, cost less than \$600 (breakdown by sport: Softball \$1800, Boys Basketball \$1400, Baseball \$984); working to compile a list of improvements like selling lifelines for \$10/answers for \$30 and \$500 to auction off coaches; Coach Gibbons to share list of improvements from coaches with THSABC to compile master list. Upcoming Spirit Nights: Cabo Bobs – 34% return, set for 11/19 and Whataburger planned for Baseball Season- date TBA;

VP Programs: Monica – will start again when Basketball starts; one game for each Girls’ and Boys’ games; Softball, Baseball; ****We need pictures****

VPs Concessions: Taryn and Mark – Will be setting up a Training Night for Volunteers (training will earn Service Hours) – in order to volunteer they have to receive training. Michael asked if we could make and post a video. Considering adding Cash option to concessions. Need to recount stock, still having items taken; can’t verify if it’s happening during volunteering or when we aren’t there... potentially check camera outside gymnasium concessions, Coach Simmons will check with Officer Herring.

VP Membership: – 146, anticipate breaking 150 soon... goal still 200

VP Spirit Wear & SM: Sara – new THS social media email; will send out after meeting so everyone has all the email addresses; Pop Up coming, hoodies coming; might try Christmas theme... received 300 bags of random items to be used during Junior High nights, including giveaways.

VP Volunteers/Team Reps: Becca– Wrestling and Basketball schedules are up for volunteers – not filling up as fast; need to emphasize to parents that they need to volunteer; will need baseball and softball as well; football closed until soccer and track.
