

A. M. W. vs JUST DO IT

GAME ONE

THIS WAS A MUST WIN SITUATION FOR BOTH TEAMS IN ORDER TO ENHANCE THEIR PLAYOFF CHANCES. AMW HAD THEIR GAME FACES ON AND WERE LOOKING TO A END A 4 GAME LOSING STREAK. 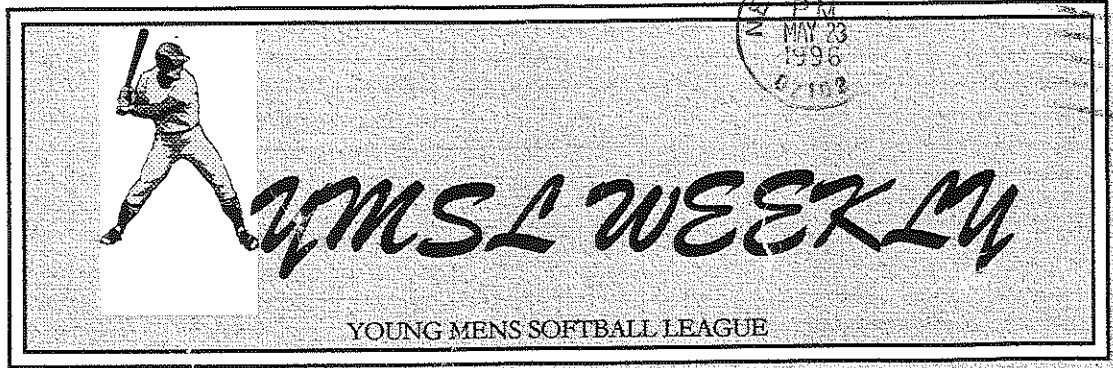
