

**Taylor High School Athletic Booster Club Board
General Meeting Minutes from February 6, 2023**

Officer Reports:

President: Brad – Scholarship apps are available to senior athletes. April 7 is the deadline for ALL THSABC scholarship applications (moved up to accommodate school awards ceremony schedule). VP Fundraising: Connie – 2 more fundraisers this year: scheduled to happen in May before Mother's Day at Kendra Scott; Whataburger Spirit Night following a Varsity baseball game TBA.

VP Spirit Wear & SM: Sara some new white hoodies and other new merch added to line up and will be available at Mustang Round Up;

VP Volunteers/Team Reps: Becca – thanked coaches and team parents for helping.

Coaches' Reports:

New Business: Mustang Round Up this Thursday 2/9 at 6:30: we need to recruit 7 new people to support existing VP positions (3 for concessions, 1 for fundraisers, 1 volunteers and 1 for spirit wear; 1 for programs); also will sell spirit wear (arrive at 5:30) and it's an opportunity to promote memberships for 2023-24; new board member level for \$50 includes 2 sports passes; an idea for next year is for sports pass pick to be available at monthly board meetings.

Softball: our first scrimmage was rained out but we have a few lined up before season officially starts next week. **Basketball:** 3 games left; four teams fighting for 3 spots in District but need to win these games; one win away from having the best record but it stay may not be enough; Fri is parent and senior night; **Wrestling:** going to regionals Fri and Sat at Merrill Center; **Boys Soccer:** has 2 more games in first round of District play; sitting in 5th place and need to win last

2 games to finish in top four. **Tennis:** is halfway done; taken home a dozen or so medals; seeing improvements and perseverance; **cheer:** wrapped up successful season and placed in top part of state competition; cheer tryouts in April, April 11 parent meeting; **Boys & Girls track:** weather cancelled practice meet but Varsity and JV track meets start next week; **Girls Basketball** play tomorrow night for senior night against Katy; **Baseball** is playing George Ranch this week and scrimmages planned for the weekend.
