When: February 20-22, 2025

We will leave from BK after the Dotty Clark race on Thursday, February 20th, heading for Alta, Wyoming. We are staying on the mountain this year so there will be no travel to and from the slopes. On the mountain, you'll have two full days to explore the 2,602 acres of terrain. Known for more than 500 inches of snowfall annually, Grand Targhee boasts the best conditions for skiers and snowboarders without the hassle of long lift lines. Whether you're looking for powder-filled laps, tree runs, or stunning Teton Valley views, Grand Targhee has it all.

Where: Grand Targhee Resort, Alta, Wyoming

Grand Targhee is nestled on the western slope of the Tetons in the Caribou-Targhee National Forest. The resort offers 2,270 feet of vertical drop with a base area elevation of 7,851 feet. Its terrain is perfect for all skill levels, with 10% beginner, 70% intermediate, 15% advanced, and 5% expert runs. Plus, there are 6 lifts serving the mountain, making sure you can spend more time skiing and less time waiting.

Who Can Go?

Anyone on the ski team is welcome to attend. The trip will be on a first paid, first going policy. Preference will be given to those who qualify for the ski team (by attending at least 3 Saturday races) and races at Dotty. We want everyone to be able to attend and have an awesome time.

How Much?

\$550 per student!! That's right! For just \$550, you'll get two nights of lodging, two days of skiing, and transportation. The price will also include small breakfast item both days, and the team will provide pizza on Friday night. All other expenses (food, gear, etc.) are extra. There are a variety of restaurants nearby, and if you need any last-minute gear, there are rental opportunities on the mountain.

What Do You Need to Do Now?

Save your spot today by completing the online SIGN-UP FORM and delivering a \$300 deposit to Mr. Godar by Wednesday, December 18th. The deposit is refundable until February 1st.

There may be a few spots available for parents on the bus. The price will depend on the number of students attending, but parents are welcome to use the group rate on lift tickets if they have their own transportation.
