Howell Ice Arena is proud to present the Winter 2019 Learn to Skate USA program. We would like to invite you and take this opportunity to welcome you to our state of the art facility. The following material explains our program and fundamental philosophy.

We offer an inexpensive, recreational group lesson for students as young as 3 years old to teenagers. The Learn to Skate USA program is designed to develop skills that the student needs to move on to our advanced figure skating or hockey programs. Our philosophy is to provide the students with the skills appropriate for their age level while having fun.

Levels are determined by the Learn to Skate USA curriculum which is endorsed by US Figure Skating, USA Hockey and US Speed skating.

The minimum enrollment is 3 students per class. The maximum enrollment is 16 students per class.

Additional coaches will be added to groups exceeding 12 students.

Classes must meet the minimum enrollment in order for the level to be offered.
